January 22, 1981

Chairman Fagg convened the Rules Committee at 11:38 a.m. in Room 343. All members were present with the exceptions of Representative Sivertsen and Representative Menahan being absent, Rep. Dussault being excused and Rep. Vincent arriving late.

There was a motion by Rep. Kemmis that all bills introduced prior to the adoption of SJR 1 rules would be going to the Clerk's Office to be assigned to the appropriate committee by the Speaker. The motion carried unanimously.

HB 131. Rep. Shontz introduced his bill to Require the National Guard Armories to keep a stock of blank ammunition for use in firing salutes to deceased veterans. There was discussion and Rep. Moore moved to table the bill so Rep. Shontz could check to see by whose authority the National Guard was not allowed to retain blank ammunitions. Rep. Vincent called the question and the motion carried unanimous.

HB 108. Rep. Ellison of District 73 presented the bill, which would create an alternative way to override the governors vetos when the legislature is not in session. There was a motion by Rep. Lund to move HB 108 to the State Administration Committee as it is connected to HB 225 which is in that committee.

Rep. Fagg closed by cancelling the scheduled committee meeting for January 23rd and adjourned the meeting.
