

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE HOUSE APPROPRIATIONS COMMITTEE
April 11, 1981

The meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m. in Room 104, State Capitol, by Chairman Lund. All members were present with the exception of REP. ERNST and HURWITZ, who were absent. REP. DONALDSON, REP. COZZENS and REP. HEMSTAD were excused.

HEARINGS

HB 872

REP. MOORE, District 41, testified as sponsor of HB 872, stating that the bill was introduced for possible alternatives within the State Capitol Building. He stated that he would like to change the number of committee members from two in the House and two in the Senate to six members from each.

REP. MOORE stated that the committee would serve as the State's representative to decide allocation and use of space in the State Capitol and that \$15,000 would be appropriated from the Capitol Land Building Account for Committee expenses.

REP. MOORE moved that HB 872 be amended to require six members from the House and six from the Senate. The motion was UNANIMOUSLY APPROVED.

REP. MOORE moved that HB 872 do pass as amended. The motion was APPROVED, with 10 members voting aye, 2 voting no and 5 members absent.

HB 187

REP. MOORE moved that HB 187 be tabled. The motion was UNANIMOUSLY APPROVED.

HB 823

REP. LORY moved that the committee reconsider its action on HB 823. The motion was approved with 10 members voting aye, 2 voting no and 5 absent.

REP. WALDRON moved that HB 823 be amended to a \$10 appropriation.

REP. MOORE stated that he feels the counties have put the program together, but that the administration in the Department of Revenue prevented proper coordination.

REP. STOBIE stated that he feels the bill should be left in Committee.

The motion, as made by REP. WALDRON was approved with 8 members voting aye and 4 voting no.

REP. LORY moved that the bill do pass as amended. The motion FAILED with 5 members voting aye and 7 voting no.

REP. MOORE moved that HB 823 do not pass. The motion was APPROVED with 7 members voting aye and 5 voting no.

HB 862

REP. LORY moved that HB 862 do pass. REP. SHONTZ made a substitute motion to table HB 862.

REP. LORY made a substitute motion for all motions pending that on page 2, line 3, 3 mills was to be stricken and 1 mill inserted, and that line 5, page 1, be amended accordingly. The motion was approved with eight members voting aye and 3 voting no. One member did not vote.

REP. LORY moved that HB 862 do pass as amended. The motion was APPROVED with 8 members voting aye and 4 voting no.

HB 868

REP. MOORE moved that HB 868 be amended as proposed in the attached amendments (Exhibit 1). The motion was UNANIMOUSLY APPROVED.

REP. MOORE moved that HB 868 do pass as amended. The motion was UNANIMOUSLY APPROVED.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:00 a.m.
