The House Rules Committee was called to order by Chairman Rep. Harrison G. Fagg in Room 343 at 8:00 p.m. this date. All members were present except Rep. Moore and Rep. Menahan arrived late.

SB 15

There was more discussion on Senate Bill 15 and the correct procedure in correcting the technical error. It was decided that the correct procedure was being taken and Rep. Dussault moved to pass the bill and refer it to second reading. The motion carried unanimously.

Regarding the previous question of the votes on constitutional amendments and whether Senate Amendments should be considered as being the last vote, Rep. Kemmis referred us to the Masons. A motion was made by Rep. Spilker to vote on amendments on second and third reading and vote on the final bill again on third reading immediately following the amendment votes. The motion carried with Rep. Vincent and Rep. Kemmis voting NO.

The Legislative Council was asked to draft a House Joint Resolution to change the rules.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned by the Chairman.

Legislative Council was also asked to draft a Resolution regarding the smoking issue.
