## MINUTES OF THE MEETING JOINT RULES COMMITTEE January 6, 1981

The Joint Rules Committee met Tuesday, January 6, 1981 in Room 415 of the Capitol Building. Senator Stan Stephens, Chairman, called the meeting to order at 2:00 p.m.

## ROLL CALL

Committee members present were Senators Stephens, Hazelbaker, Turnage, Kolstad, Smith, Galt, Blaylock, Norman, Graham, Boylan, Representatives Fagg, Marks, Moore, Spilker, Sivertsen, Lund, Vincent, Dussault, Kemmis, and Menahan.

## ACTION ON PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SJR 1 & REVIEW OF BILL:

Chairman Stephens explained that the proposed amendments are the result of the caucuses of the Interim Committee on Legislative Improvement. Discussion was called for.

Senator Turnage asked the question of whether the proposed new language "If the originating house does not finally act within 5 legislative days on a veto received while in session, the bill is dead" would be limiting ourselves to the extent our hands would be tied? Senator Blaylock wanted to know the original reason for adding this language. Chairman Stephens said the Governor's office had asked for it.

Senator Turnage moved that the new material, in question, on Page 33, lines 23, 24, & 25 be deleted. Motion carried. Senator Graham is recorded voting no, and explained that he felt the language was put in the bill for a reason.

Representative Moore moved to strike "at the time of introduction on the first legislative day", on lines 9 and 10, and insert "at any time prior to a standing committee report on the bill" on line 11, Page 21. Motion carried.

Representative Dussault moved that all the underlined material on Page 47, lines 23 through "journal" on line 2, page 48 be stricken and insert "Roll call votes shall be taken by ayes and noes and the names entered on the journal on adopting an adverse committee report and on those motions made in committee of the whole referred to in Joint Rule 6-26(1) (a)-(d)" on Page 31. Motion carried

The inconsistencies on Page 30, lines 5 & 6 were questioned by Representative Marks.

Senator Turnage moved to insert following 6-2 on Page 17, line 14, "All bill drafting reuqests shall require a legislative sponsor". Motion carried. Senator Blaylock voted no.

Representative Marks moved to add another category to Section 6-6 which would appear as Sub-section (f) "standing committee bills". Motion carried.

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Senator Blatisidek moved to adopt the amendments to SJR 1 vited on at this meeting. Motion carried
