

MINUTES OF THE MEETING  
JOINT RULES COMMITTEE  
February 11, 1981

The Senate Rules met as the Joint Rules Committee with the House Rules doing likewise, on Wednesday, February 11, 1981 in Room 331 of the State Capitol. Senator Stan Stephens, Chairman, called the meeting to order at 4:45 p.m.

ROLL CALL

All members were present except Senator Smith, Reps. Kemmis, Vincent, Sivertsen, and Menehan.  
(Rather than schedule a joint meeting of the Rules Committee it was decided to meet separately with a combined meeting recorded.)

The matter before us is explained in the letter from Diana Dowling, Executive Director of the Legislative Council (EXHIBIT I). It is simply a clerical matter of reinserting material that was overlooked during the reprinting of the 1979 Rule books pertaining to the transmittal date for Interim Study Resolutions and Joint Resolutions that concern administrative rules (6-7 and 6-34).

Senator Turnage moved to submit the standing committee report necessary to accomplish the correction. Motion carried.
