

MINUTES OF THE MEETING  
LEGISLATIVE ADMINISTRATION COMMITTEE  
MONTANA STATE SENATE

January 9, 1981

The second meeting of the Legislative Administration Committee was called to order by Senator Kolstad, Chairman, at 9:30 a.m. on the above date in Room 415 of the State Capitol building.

ROLL CALL: All members of the committee were present except Senator Graham who was absent.

Representative Spilker was introduced to the committee and explained HJR 3 which concerns the classification, pay, and other conditions of employment of legislative employees. She said that this resolution will start all new employees with no previous experience in the legislature at step 2 of the grade set for each position. (See Exhibit #1) She also said that the rostrum help and the officers' secretaries would be considered to be executive employees which would put them in grade 11 by this resolution. She added that pages were given more than the minimum wage and would be set at grade 1, step 9, of the state pay plan. After she concluded her testimony, Senator Kolstad thanked her and asked if the committee had any questions.

MOTION: Following a question and answer period, Senator McCallum moved that HJR 3 BE CONCURRED IN, and the motion carried unanimously.

Senator Mazurek at this time told the committee that the Helena schools would only let pages off for one week and asked if that would entitle senators having one-week pages to two pages. Senator Kolstad told him that they would arrange for those senators to have two pages for one week each.

There being no further business, the committee adjourned.
