#### MINUTES OF THE MEETING PUBLIC HEALTH, WELFARE & SAFETY MONTANA STATE SENATE

#### JANUARY 19, 1981

The meeting of the Public Health, Welfare & Safety Committee was called to order by Chairman Tom Hager on Monday, January 19, 1981 at 1:00 p.m. in Room 410 of the State Capitol Building.

ROLL CALL: All members were present. Kathleen Harrington, staff researcher, was also present.

DISPOSITION OF SENATE BILL 73: This bill is an act to automatically assign support rights of persons applying for public assistance to the Department of Social and Rehabilitation Services, and providing an immediate effective date. Senator Hager pointed out that at the last Committee Meeting, the Committee had neglected to amend the title of this bill to correspond with the rest of the bill. The amendments would be: 1) Title, line 8; Following: "THE"; Insert: "STATE, THE". 2) Title, line 8; Following: "SERVICES"; Insert: ",AND THE COUNTY WELFARE DEPARTMENT".

A motion was made by Senator Norman to accept the above amendments nos. 1 & 2. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Senator Halligan to give the recommendation of <u>as amended of this date</u>, <u>DO PASS</u> from the Committee. Motion carried unanimously.

DISPOSITION OF SENATE BILL 37: This bill is an act to establish a Montana Tumor Registry and to require reporting by hospitals of information on patients with tumors. The amendments submitted by the Montana Hospital Association were reviewed. Each amendment was reviewed seperately.

Amendment #1: Page 2, line 2; Following: "shall"; Insert: "make records available to personel from the Montana Tumor Registry established by (Section 5) or". Senator Himsl stated that several hospitals are now participating in the registering of tumors, however, several of the smaller hospitals are not. This bill would make the records more complete. Senator Johnson asked how many people would the state have to hire to do the reports. If the amendment were adopted several hospitals would expect the state to come in and make out the reports. Senator Himsl did not feel that the reports would be too burdensome for the hospitals. PUBLIC HEALTH, WELFARE & SAFETY PAGE TWO

A motion was made by Senator Olson that Amendment #1 be NOT ADOPTED. Motion carried.

Amendment #2: Page 2, line 5; Following: "."; Insert: "If the hospital utilizes its personnel to complete the report, the department shall pay the hospital \$3.00 for each report completed and submitted to the department."

A motion was made by Senator Halligan that Amendment #2 be NOT ADOPTED. Motion carried.

Amendment #3: Page 3, line 2; Strike: Section 7 in its entirety; Renumber: subsequent subsection. Senator Berg stated that the mandatory part of the bill is a must. Senator Norman asked if the \$500 being levied was for each report or per day or per month. A motion was made by Senator Berg that Amendment #3 be NOT ADOPTED. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Senator Berg that Senate Bill 37 receive a <u>DO PASS</u> recommendation from the Committee. Motion carried unanimously.

ANNOUNCEMENTS: Senator Hager announced that the next meeting will be held on Wednesday, January 21 at 1:00 to hear Senate Bill 127.

ADJOURN: With no further business the meeting was adjourned.
