All members present with the exception of Senator Galt and Senator Boylan.


ACTION TAKEN ON RESOLUTIONS BY B. BROWN AND HAFFERMAN

In compliance with a new Joint Rule 6-6(6), that a simple resolution must be approved by the Rules Committee of the house introducing it and a stamp indicating such approval shall be affixed to the cover of the resolution before presentation to the Secretary of the Senate, the committee met to consider two such resolutions.

Senator Turnage moved to accept for introduction Senator Brown's resolution requesting the Federal Government to fully fund forest fire protection assistance from the McNary Fire Fighting Fund. Motion carried.

Senator Kolstad moved to accept for introduction Senator Hafferman's resolution urging Congress and other branches of federal government to study and implement ways to make groups intervening in proceedings relating to the construction of energy generation facilities legally and financially responsible for their action. Motion carried.

The meeting adjourned at 3:25 p.m.
