

MINUTES OF THE MEETING
LEGISLATIVE ADMINISTRATION COMMITTEE
MONTANA STATE SENATE

February 10, 1981

The fifth meeting of the Legislative Administration Committee was called to order by Chairman Kolstad at 5:10 p.m. in Room 415 of the Capitol building on the above date.

ROLL CALL: All members of the committee were present except Senator Hazelbaker who was absent.

Senator Turnage, President of the Senate, appeared in committee at this time and requested that the committee introduce a bill to generally revise the laws relating to deferred compensation plans for public employees. Our present law has to be amended before January 1, 1982 to bring them in accord with the federal law. Under this program, state employees could defer part of their earnings and not pay income tax until drawn out.

At the request of Senator Turnage, David Evensen of the Department of Administration, Personnel Division, spoke briefly about the plan.

At this time, Senator Kolstad, Chairman, thanked both Senator Turnage and Mr. Evensen for appearing before the committee.

DISPOSITION: Senator Mazurek moved that a committee bill be drafted at the request of this committee. Motion carried.

There being no further business at this time, the meeting adjourned at 5:25 p.m.
