FAPRESSING INTENT OF THE LEFISLATURE IN PLANS FOR REMODELING OF THE CAPITOL".

Senator Thomas appeared before the committee with an update on the Long Range Building Program, with regard to remodeling of the Capitol. He explained that approximately six million dollars will be derived from receipts from forest funds which can only be spent on remodeling of the Capitol. The resolution was introduced to gain some input and direction on accomplishing the improvements to the Capitol.

There is an abundance of information on file in Phil Hauck's office on all thases of the removation, and a complete presentation will be given to the full assembly later in the session.

The concensus is to keep the resolution alive to preserve the grant funds until further information can be gleaned for a basis to act upon.

Senator Blaylock moved that the resolution be amended in the Committee of the Whole to provide space for the offices of the Legislative Fiscal Analyst, Legislative Council, and Legislative Auditor, and to appoint Senator Thomas and John Larson, Secretary of the Senate, to work as a committee in consultation with the State Architect. Further, to recommend that the resolution be not considered a revenue matter for purposes of transmittal. Motion carried.
