MINUTES OF THE MEETING FINANCE AND CLAIMS COMMITTEE MONTANA STATE SENATE

March 12, 1981

The 21st meeting of the Senate Finance and Claims Committee met on the above date in room 108 of the State Capitol Building. The meeting was called to order by Senator Himsl at 6:30 p.m. for the purpose of considering House Bills 610 and 611. Roll call was taken with all members except Senators Etchart and Stimatz present.

<u>DISPOSITION OF HOUSE BILL</u> 610: Senator Smith moved the amendments to HOUSE BILL 610 as presented.

Substitute motion by Senator Haffey that when the ANB (average number belonging) for the current school year as calculated and is found to be 3% or more below the ANB for the previous year, the ANB which may be used for budget purposes for the ensuing school fiscal year be the actual ANB for the previous year reduced by 3%. Exhibit 1.

Senator Haffey's substitute motion was rejected by a vote, (roll call, attached) 8-6.

Vote on the original MOTION by Senator Smith was taken, and the motion passed, unanimously by those present, Senators Smith and Stimatz absent.

Senator Van Valkenburg questioned the need to act so quickly. Senator Smith reported that we should not postpone action, and the quicker the better to help schools plan by putting more money into their budgets, and he said all of them wanted the bill out.

Senator Haffey again explained his proposal by suggesting that it was proper for the state to share the loss when the enrollments were dropping from high to low. He said he could understand why the 6% trigger presented a problem where those with a 5.9 decrease would get nothing and those above received the full 6%, He advised, that in checking the information he received, that the decline would appear to be about 3.2 in the highschools and 3% in the grades. He indicated that a fiscal note was being prepared but there was no indication of what the cost would be.

Senator Dover suggested that we don't have any figures and we can't act on this bill, and if the information is available you can amend it on the floor.

Senator Smith suggested that there was House Bill 655 which

he understood contained a 3 year rolling average. He felt Senator Haffey's proposal might be amended into that bill.

Senator Keating asked when the 6% figure becomes operative and he would advise that there is no provision in the law to cover declining attendance, only when there is an increase.

Senator Aklestad made a MOTION that HOUSE BILL 610, as amended, be CONCURRED IN. Question was called and the vote was unanimous of committee members present, Senators Stimatz and Etchart being absent.

Senator Smith moved adjournment, and the meeting was adjourned at 7:15 p.m.
