MINUTES OF THE MEETING STATE ADMINISTRATION COMMITTEE MONTANA STATE SENATE

March 17, 1981

The Senate State Administration Committee was called to order by Senator Pete Story, Chairman, on the above date in room 442 of the State Capitol Building at 10 a.m.

ROLL CALL: All members of the committee were present, excepting Senator Hammond.

ACTION ON HOUSE BILL 98: Senator Hafferman moved DO PASS; discussion followed concerning the widows who would be involved; motion carried by unanimous vote of all present; Senator Hammond submitted a written vote, and Senator Ryan will carry it on the floor.

ACTION ON HOUSE BILL 102: Amendments were submitted by John Hollow. Discussion followed by Senator Ryan stating that land would go into the account while the other revenues based on production would go into the general fund.

A spelling error will be corrected on the bill.

Senator Johnson moved they pass the amendments; motion carried. She moved the bill <u>DO PASS AS AMENDED</u>. Motion carried by unanimous vote. Senator Story will carry bill on the floor.

ACTION ON HOUSE BILL 135: John Hollow explained the amendments; discussion followed. Senator Towe moved the amendments pass; motion carried. He then moved the bill <u>DO PASS, AS AMENDED</u>; motion carried by unanimous vote. See standing committee report Senator Towe will carry bill on the floor.

ACTION ON HOUSE BILL 147: Senator Towe moved DO PASS; motion carried by unanimous vote and Senator Kolstad will carry bill on the floor.

ACTION ON HOUSE BILL 161: Senator Johnson explained the subcommittee's report. Bud Gould concurred that the highway department be the guinea pig. It was suggested it be a pilot program, and it will be sunsetted.

Senator Ryan moved house bill 161 do not pass, and he said limiting it to one department is not a good idea. A straw vote was cast with only Senator Ryan voting yes.

Senator Johnson said this could come to the legislature. Senatc Ryan gave an example that he could receive a reward for eliminating his boss's job. Page two State Administration Meeting Minutes March 17, 1981

Senator Johnson asked Patricia Moore her opinion, and she asked if the advisory council and the department of administratio would be involved. She pointed out items 6 and 8 in the statement of intent, and said the cost savings and morale would be statewide. There was discussion of whether or not to take out advisory council, and Mr. Tom Schneider, visitor, said it should be left in.

The amendments were moved by Senator Towe. The statement of intent was changed.

Senator Johnson moved HOUSE BILL 161 DO PASS AS AMENDED; motion carried with Senator Ryan voting no. See standing committee report. Senator Johnson will carry bill on the floor.

ACTION ON HOUSE BILL 197: The amendments submitted by John Hollow will conform to HOUSE BILL 573 by Nordtvedt. Senator Towe moved the amendments pass; motion carried. Senator Towe explained the bill and said page 8 is the key part of the bill. Mr. Schneider explained the bill also. Discussion followed, and Senator Towe moved DO PASS, AS AMENDED. Motion carried by unanimous vote. Senator Towe will carry the bill on the floor.

ACTION ON HOUSE BILL 270: An amendment in the title was submitted by John Hollow. Senator Towe moved the bill do not pass and explained his reason that they have to send a certain number of delegates to the conventions. This motion failed. See roll call vote.

Senator Johnson moved Mr. Hollow's amendment on line 6, do pass; motion carried. Senator Kolstad moved the bill <u>DO PASS, AS</u> <u>AMENDED</u>; motion carried by majority. Reverse note seen on the roll call vote resulted in Senators Hafferman, Ryan and Towe voting no. Senator Story will carry the bill on the floor.

ACTION ON HOUSE BILL 584: Senator Towe moved the bill DO PASS; motion carried by unanimous vote. Senator Hammond will carry the bill on the floor.

ACTION ON HOUSE BILL 657: Senator Hafferman moved this bill DO PASS. Discussion followed with Senator Towe pointing out the problem of the appointment of a chief justice every time and problems that arise when the secretary of state runs for office.

Senator Ryan said they become a nonentity.

Senator Towe thought the secretary of state could make small decisions.
