ACTION TAKEN ON S.B. 278 (referred to Rules from second reading)
"TO REMOVE THE PROHIBITION AGAINST GRANTING A MINING PERMIT
BECAUSE OF ECOLOGICAL FRAGILITY OF THE AREA TO BE MINED;
AMENDING SECTION 82-4-227, MCA."

Senator Graham explained that the Conroy amendment in the House dated March 25, 1981 amended out of the bill the part that conforms to the title, thereby changing the intent of the bill. He really doesn't feel the bill can be corrected by further amendment.

Senator Graham moved that S.B. 278 be tabled. Motion carried.
