April 22, 1981

The Senate Rules Committee met Wednesday, April 22, 1981 in Room 31 of the State Capitol. Senator Stan Stephens, Chairman, called the meeting to order at 3:20 p.m.

ROLL CALL

All members were present except Senator Kolstad.

ACTION TAKEN ON HJR 68

ON A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA TO ADOPT RULES RELATING TO VOTES ON BILLS REQUIRING MORE THAN A MAJORITY VOTE".

This is a joint resolution introduced by Representative Fagg to spell out the rule on which vote on concurrence in amendments of the other house is the vote by which the originating house adopts a measure.

It was agreed that if the amendments are accepted and the bill is of a type requiring more than a majority vote for passage, the bill shall again be placed on third reading in the house of origin. The vote on third reading after concurrence in amendments is the vote of the house of origin that must be used to determine if the required number of votes has been cast. The same thing applies to conference committee reports.

Senator Blaylock moved to adopt HJR 68. Motion carried.
