



HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
LEGISLATIVE ADMINISTRATION COMMITTEE

The Legislative Administration Committee meeting was called to order by the chairman, Representative Bobby Spilker. All members of the committee were present; also Don Byrd, Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives, and Sharole Connelly, Accounting Division of the Legislative Council.

The purpose of the meeting was to approve the list of employees for the special session. For the most part, the same people were hired as before, with a few new ones. Five of those persons will be doing more than one job. This being the case, the following persons have grade changes to compensate for extra duties: Ruth Leu, Louise Trenta, Paul Fossum, Reed Wolstein, and Julia Vogl. Also, the aide to Representative Gould will be placed on a grade-step salary basis instead of the \$1000 a month salary, if it is agreeable to both Representative Gould and his aide. Everyone stayed on the same step. However, the new salary matrix for 1981-82 is being used. This new matrix includes a cost-of-living raise effective July 1981.

No one having any further questions, Representative Curtiss made a motion that the committee accept the list of employees. It was seconded by Representative Kanduch, and carried unanimously. With no further discussion, Representative Meyer made a motion to adjourn. Carried unanimously.
