

47th SPECIAL SESSION II

MINUTES OF MEETING
OF
THE SENATE JUDICIARY COMMITTEE

The fifth meeting of the Senate Judiciary Committee was called to order at 4:15 p.m., June 25, 1982, in Room 331 of the State Capitol Building with Chairman Mike Anderson presiding.

ROLL CALL: Roll call found all of the members present.

The Chairman stated HJR 4, previously heard by the Joint House-Senate Committee, would be coming over from the House as it had received a Do Pass from that body. Copies of the bill were distributed to the committee members so they might again review the proposed legislation and there followed some discussion on the bill. Sen. O'Hara was one of the signers of Rep. Gould's bill and he briefly reviewed its intent for the committee.

Sen. O'Hara stated HJR4 enforced present law stating the Parole Board must review parole applications annually, and the legislation merely gave the Board extra 'clout' in the matter. More frequent reviews would mean additional work for the Board and the bill would assure no change be made in present statutes in this regard. Several of the committee members questioned O'Hara regarding the necessity of this legislation since it is already part of the law.

Sen. Mazurek Moved HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 4 Be Concurred In. By a roll call vote, see attached, the motion failed 4 Yes, 6 No. Thus the bill will remain in committee unless a new motion is made.

At the June 22nd meeting Sen. Steve Brown made a motion, which passed unanimously, that a member of the Legislative Council draw up a committee bill, or resolution, which would embody Sen. Boylan's SB2, which the committee sent out of the committee with a Do Not Pass report. Sen. Brown withdrew this motion after reconsideration.

The committee then discussed Sen. Ryan's Senate Bill 4, already heard by the committee. The bill was not moved at the time of hearing, and remains in this committee.

Sen. Steve Brown then Moved SENATE BILL 4 DO PASS. The motion failed by a 5-5 Tie vote, thus will remain unless moved again. A roll call vote was taken, attached.

Following this motion Chairman Anderson adjourned the meeting.
