

MINUTES OF MEETING  
OF LEGISLATIVE ADMINISTRATION

February 11, 1983

A meeting of the Legislative Administration Committee was held in Room 343, at approximately 7:00 P.M. Members present were Chairman Menahan, Representative Jan Brown, Representative Donaldson, and Representative Zabrocki.

The Chairman had called this meeting to draft a resolution regarding the space available in the Capitol.

After a brief discussion, the members determined that the House should have at least two-thirds of the space available as the House had one-hundred members, and the Senate only had fifty.
