

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE APPROPRIATIONS SUBCOMMITTEE ON
NATURAL RESOURCES AND BUSINESS REGULATION
January 6, 1983

THE APPROPRIATIONS SUBCOMMITTEE ON NATURAL RESOURCES AND BUSINESS REGULATION met at 9:00 a.m. on January 6, 1983, in Room 132. Chairman Rex Manuel presided and all members were present.
