In 1981 326.81 FTE handled 7085 AFDC cases. Projected number of cases over the 1985 biennium is 6315, or a 15% reduction from 1981.

Current level FTE is 303.81 over the 1985 biennium, only a 7% reduction from 1981 levels.

Difference is due to executive adding \$9,683 to actual FY 1982 base, whereas LFA did not.

Executive added \$9,683 to base per the department's request, which argued that positions vacant in FY 1982 could be filled in future years. Filling those positions could result in more travel.

LFA did not add to base because vacant positions reflecting 20.6 FTE were deleted.
