MINUTES OF MEETING OF THE SENATE RULES COMMITTEE January 26, 1983

The second meeting of the Senate Rules Committee was called to order by its chairman, Senator Frank W. Hazelbaker, on January 26, 1983 at 3:45 P.M., in Room 331 of the capitol building.

Senator Turnage stated that based upon the testimony of Senator Conover the bill was submitted within the rules, and moved the bill be accepted. The motion was unanimously carried.
