# MINUTES OF MEETING OF THE SENATE RULES COMMITTEE January 27 and 28, 1983

The third meeting of the Senate Rules Committee was called to order by its chairman, Senator Frank W. Hazelbaker, at 4:00 P.M. on January 27, 1983, in room 331 of the state capitol building.

## ROLL CALL:

All members were present.

## CONSIDERATION OF HOUSE RULES COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 1, 3rd READING COPY:

Senator Hazelbaker advised the committee that the purpose of the meeting was to discuss the House amendments to Senate Joint Resolution 1.

The President of the Senate, Stan Stephens, read the changes as proposed by the House.

Discussion followed. Senator Towe remarked that under present rules, all revenue measures are transmitted by the 70th day. Under the new rules, the House has to send to the Senate a balanced budget by the 70th day, see page 21.

Senator Turnage said that the language on page 21 does not actually say that the House must transmit a balanced budget on the 70th day.

General concern was expressed that the Senate would lose power if revenue bills were to originate in the House.

Senator Regan asked Diana Dowling, Executive Director of the Legislative Council, to research the records over the past five years, to determine the procedural history of appropriation bills.

Chairman Hazelbaker recessed the meeting at 4:50 P.M. until adjournment of the Senate's session on January 28th, 1983.

The Senate Rules Committee re-convened its third meeting on January 28, 1983 at 4:50 P.M.

All members were present.

The members of the committee discussed their recommendations to the Conference Committee of three Senators appointed by the President of the Senate this date to confer with a like number of House Members appointed by the Speaker for the purpose of considering amendments to SJR 1.

Senator Turnage said the intent of the Senate Rules Committee is that the transmittal of the balanced budget by the House shall be

on or before the 70th day, and that the Senate would have until the 50th day to transmit its revenue measures.

All members voted aye in favor of the recommendations.

There being no further business to come before the committee, the meeting was adjourned at 5:07 P.M.
