

MINUTES OF MEETING OF THE
SENATE RULES COMMITTEE
February 4, 1983

The fourth meeting of the Senate Rules Committee was called to order by its chairman, Senator Frank W. Hazelbaker, at 4:05 o'clock P.M. on February 4, 1983, in Room 331, Capitol Building.

ROLL CALL:

All members were present.

CONSIDERATION OF SENATE RESOLUTION 4:

Senator Blaylock questioned the propriety of using a simple resolution, and suggested that a Joint Resolution would be the proper procedure.


Senator Towe said that the rules would have to be suspended to allow a simple resolution, and that a two-third's vote to suspend the rules would be required.

Senator Stephens pointed out that historically, ten years ago, the Senate and the House had responded to this question by each house issuing its own resolution.

Senator Towe moved the resolution not be accepted for second reading without suspending the rules to do so. With Senators Blaylock, Regan and Towe voting aye, and Senators Aklestad, Stephens, Turnage and Hazelbaker voting nay, the motion was defeated.

Senator Turnage moved that SR 4 is properly before the floor for consideration on second reading this day. This motion was approved with Senators Aklestad, Stephens, Turnage and Hazelbaker voting aye and Senators Blaylock, Regan and Towe voting nay.

The meeting was adjourned at 4:25 P.M.
