

MINUTES OF THE MEETING
PUBLIC HEALTH, WELFARE AND SAFETY COMMITTEE
MONTANA STATE SENATE

FEBRUARY 12, 1983

The meeting of the Public Health, Welfare and Safety Committee was called to order in a special session by Chairman Tom Hager on Saturday, February 12, 1983 in Room 410 of the State Capitol Building.

ROLL CALL: All members were present with the exception of Senator Marbut, who was excused because of a prior committment. Woody Wright, staff attorney, was also present.

CONSIDERATION OF A COMMITTEE BILL: Senator Hager explained to the Committee that a Committee Bill would now be necessary to replace Senate Bill 31.


Senator Norman stated that he did not think that it would be necessary and that there would not be any problem in getting it through the Rules Committee, however, he did not have any problem with the idea of a Committee Bill.

Mr. Wright explained that he had visited with the proper channels in the Legislative Council, and it was felt by everyone that this would be the route to take.

Senator Hager stated that he would feel better about it, if a Committee Bill were to be requested.

A motion was made by Senator Norman that the Committee have a bill drafted which would replace Senate Bill 31. All members voting "aye", the motion carried unanimously.
