

MINUTES OF THE MEETING  
STATE ADMINISTRATION COMMITTEE  
MONTANA STATE SENATE

February 12, 1983

A special meeting of the Senate State Administration Committee was called to order by Senator Pete Story, Chairman on February 12, 1983 at 2:49 p.m. in Room 331 of the State Capitol Building in Helena, Montana.

ROLL CALL: All members were present.

The meeting was called for the purpose of drafting a committee bill.

SENATOR STORY said a problem has arisen because the Attorney General told the Finance and Claims Committee that they can't put in the boiler plate language.

Senator Turnage drafted this at the request of Judy Rippingale. and the rule is that it takes six out of seven members to request a committee bill. Senator Story said that if this is approved it will be heard Tuesday.

SENATOR TURNAGE reported that today is the last day for requests of bills and that he had spoken to Senator Story several days ago but time didn't permit the committee to hear this request. He said that he has been working with Judy Rippingale on the problem, part of which arose out of an Attorney General's opinion. He said that he would like the committee to authorize introduction of this bill. Senator Story stated that he won't try to convince them that they will have to vote for the bill later.


SENATOR TOWE MOVED that the bill be authorized for drafting.

DISCUSSION: SENATOR TOWE stated that he thinks they should get the bill in and take a look at it. He said that one thing that bothers him is that in putting in language, the whole appropriations thus will have to be rejected or accepted and that they will have no chance to disagree.

SENATOR TURNAGE said that the governor would still have the right to amend the language. He said that even though this bill would have an impact, it is not an appropriation bill.
