The fifth meeting of the Senate Rules Committee was called to order by its chairman, Senator Frank W. Hazelbaker, at 4:30 P.M. in Room 331 of the Capitol Building. All members were present.


President Stan Stephens advised that Speaker of the House Dan Kemmis had written him a letter which requested that the Senate Rules Committee address the following bills allowing them to be considered at the same time as appropriation bills: House Bills 48, 105, 109, 112, 237, 286, 288, 392, 413, 419, 613, 649 and 681.

Chairman Hazelbaker suggested that the committee consider each bill individually. After discussion on the above bills, it was decided by the committee that only House Bills 105, 112 and 659 were deemed to be within the rules as appropriation bills.

Senator Turnage moved that the President of the Senate be instructed to respond to the Speaker of the House that House Bills 105, 112 and 659 were approved by the Senate Rules Committee as falling within the realm of appropriation bills and may be transmitted after the 45th legislative day.

The motion passed unanimously.
