ACTION ON SENATE BILL NO. 449:

Senator Galt moved that Senate Bill No. 449 be tabled. The Committee voted unanimously by voice vote to TABLE SENATE BILL NO. 449.

ACTION ON SENATE BILL NO. 425:

Senator Goodover moved that Senate Bill No. 425 Do Pass. On a Roll Call Vote, the Committee voted 6-2 that SENATE BILL NO. 425 DO PASS. This Roll Call Vote is attached.

ACTION ON SENATE BILL NO. 197:

Senate Bill No. 463 is an act to provide extended unemployment benefit coverage.

Harold Kansier, representing the Department of Labor, further explained the bill to the Committee.


There were no opponents of Senate Bill No. 463 present at the hearing.

Insert: "Such percentage points may not be used to appoint a preferred person over a substantially equally qualified non-preferred person who is a member of an affected class, where there is evidence demonstrating past or present underutilization of the affected class by the public hiring authority involved."

2) Page 6, line 16.

Following: "qualifications"

Insert: "except where the non-preferred person is a member of an affected class and there is evidence demonstrating past or present underutilization of the affected class by the public hiring authority involved"
