

MINUTES OF THE MEETING
AGRICULTURE, LIVESTOCK AND IRRIGATION
MONTANA STATE SENATE

March 18, 1983

The Agriculture, Livestock and Irrigation Committee meeting was called to order on the above date, in Room 415 of the State Capitol Building, at 1:00 p.m., by Chairman Galt.

ROLL CALL: Senator Kolstad excused, all other members present.

DISPOSITION OF HOUSE BILL 646: Senator Conover moved to adopt the amendments proposed by Representative Lory, Exhibit #1. Motion carried.

Senator Lee moved HB 646, as amended, BE NOT CONCURRED IN. Motion carried. For the record, Senators Conover and Lane voted NO. Senator Ochsner was not present at this time.

Senator Lee will carry the bill.

DISPOSITION OF HOUSE BILL 762: Senator Lee moved HB 762 BE NOT CONCURRED IN. Motion carried unanimously. Senator Lee will carry the bill.

DISPOSITION OF HOUSE BILL 118: Senator Lee moved to amend page 1, line 15: Strike \$50, insert \$35. Motion carried.

Senator Lee moved HB 118, as amended, BE CONCURRED IN. Motion carried unanimously.

Senator Lee will carry the bill.


DISPOSITION OF HOUSE BILL 770: Senator Lee moved to amend page 3, line 19: following "system" strike the remainder of line 19 through "be" on line 20 and insert "to serve a parcel of land to be built upon or" and on page 3, line 20 following "converted" strike "into" and insert "for". Motion carried.

Senator Lee moved HB 770, as amended, BE CONCURRED IN. Motion carried.

Senator Lee will carry the bill.

Senator Galt told the committee they are still waiting on the amendments for HB 545. He called a committee meeting for Wednesday, March 23, at 1:00 p.m. for executive action on this bill.

There being no further business, the meeting adourned.

Attached you will find a copy of the calculations used to determine the fee that should be charged for the review of subdivision lots. Assumptions have been made as to the number of lots which will be submitted for review during the coming biennium. These assumptions were based on the number of lots submitted during the last two years and are as follows:

Minor lots-----	2017
Major lots -----	2539
Trailer lots -----	323

Total lots -----	4879

Records from the past seven years indicate that one staff FTE is needed for every 1200 - 1300 lots submitted for review. This is due in part to the fact that the law requires that the Department must give final action on the proposed plan within 60 days.

The submittal of approx. 5000 lots will require a staff of 4 FTE. A budget for such a staff was submitted to and tentatively approved by the Joint Appropriation sub-committee for Human Services. Calculations were then made to determine the revenue that would be generated from review fee levels of \$30, \$35, \$40, \$45 and \$50 keeping in mind that the State does not retain the entire amount but refunds a portion of the fee to local units of government that assist in the review.

From the attached sheets you will see that an increase to \$50 is necessary to support the required staff.


