# MINUTES OF NATURAL RESOURCES COMMITTEE MONTANA STATE SENATE

March 18, 1983

An executive session of the Senate Natural Resources Committee was called to order by Senator Harold L. Dover, Chairman, at 12:30 p.m. on Friday, March 18, 1983 in Room 405, Capitol Building, Helena, MT.

ROLL CALL: Roll was called by the secretary, a majority of members was present, Senators Lee, Van Valkenburg and Manning were excused.

ACTION ON HOUSE BILL 228: Senator Halligan presented amendments to the bill, attached as Exhibit 'l'. Page 2, line 13, following "made" insert "a financial", and insert "after completing an application for an environmental permit". Page 2, line 16, strike "rules" and insert "requirements in such a permit". Page 2, line 17, following "detriment" "Therefore when a person makes a financial commitment after completing an application for an environmental permit it is the policy of the state not to change the requirements in such a permit to the detriment of such persons except upon a showing of clear and convincing evidence of a need to protect public health, the environment or comply with federal regulations." The title was also to be amended. Senator Halligan moved the amendments. All voted 'aye' and motion carried. Senator Halligan moved that HB 228 Be Concurred In as amended, motion carried by all voting 'aye'. Senator Halligan would carry the bill on the floor.

There being no further business to come before the committee the meeting was duly adjourned.
