
There being no adverse reports made on any of the appointees submitted it was the decision of the committee to act on them as a whole.

I am submitting to you biographical information on appointments recently made by Governor Schwinden.

DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE

As a member of the BOARD OF ARCHITECTS

Robert C. Utzinger - Utzinger received a bachelor's degree in business administration in 1956 from the University of Colorado, a bachelor's degree in architectural engineering in 1961 from the University of Colorado and a master's degree in architecture from the University of Michigan in 1969. Utzinger is a registered architect in the states of Colorado, Wyoming and Montana, and is a licensed engineer in Colorado. He served as the director of the school of architecture at the University of Colorado from 1972-1978, and is currently the Director of the School of Architecture at Montana State University. He is also the chairman of the Facilities Planning and Utilization Board at MSU.

Utzinger succeeds Harold Rose, Bozeman, and will serve as the board member who is required to be a registered architect on the staff of the Montana State University School of Architecture.

He will serve a term ending March 27, 1986.

As a member of the BOARD OF DENTISTRY

John T. Noonan, D.D.S. - Dr. Noonan graduated from Butte Central High School in 1953, attended Carroll College from 1953-1955 and graduated from Creighton University School of Dentistry, Omaha, Nebraska, in 1959. He served in the U.S. Air Force and was honorably discharged in 1962 with the rank of captain.

Dr. Noonan served as chairman of the Peer Review Committee for the Fourth District Dental Society from 1979-82, is a member of the American Academy of General Dentistry and has had a private dental practice in Great Falls since 1962.

Dr. Noonan succeeds Dr. William G. Thomas, Hobson, as one of five licensed dentists who serve on the seven-member board.

He will serve a term ending March 29, 1988.

Thor A. Jackola Jackola received a bachelor's degree in 1962 from Michigan Technological University, Houghton, Michigan. He is currently president, stockholder and operations manager for Jackola Engineering Co., a Kalispell-based general contracting company.

Jackola, a mechanical engineer, replaces R.L. Prussing of Billings and serves as the registered professional engineer on the nine-member board.

He will serve a term ending May 4, 1984.

Sonia M. Hoffmann - Hoffmann, a third generation Montanan, was born in Terry, and raised and educated in Billings. She has been a student of voice and music for the past ten years, a writer of fiction and poetry and an artist in several mediums including water color and pastel. She is also a free-lance commercial artist and illustrator. Hoffmann is a member of the Helena branch of the Montana Institute of Arts, the Helena Symphony Choral, the Helena Cathedral Choral and the Helena Old House Club. She succeeds Maxine Blackmier, Missoula, on the council.

She will serve a term ending February 1, 1988.

Shirley L. Hanson - Hanson received a bachelor's degree in elementary education from Eastern Montana College in 1967. She later did graduate studies at both Montana State University and the University of Montana. She taught elementary music in Baker, Montana, from 1966-70, and in Havre from 1971 to the present. Hanson is a member of the Havre, Montana, and National Education Associations, the Montana Music Educators Association, the Montana and American Choral Directors Associations and the Montana Institute of the Arts Foundation Advocacy.

She was reappointed to serve a term ending February 1, 1988.

Howard Hunke - Hunke received a bachelor's degree in 1959 from Dickinson State, Dickinson, North Dakota, and a master's degree in music education from the University of Montana in 1964. He was director of all music activities for the school system in New Town, North Dakota, from 1959 to 1962 and was chairman of the music department in Sidney schools from 1962 to 1977. He has been the director of the Sidney Community Band since 1979, is a member of the Elks Club, the Lions Club, the National, Montana and Sidney Education Associations and was president of the Montana Bandmasters Association. Hunke is currently the owner and operator of Kentucky Fried Chicken in Sidney and Glendive.

Irene Claudette Johnson - Johnson received a bachelor's degree in 1963 from the University of Montana and a master's degree in drama from the University of Montana in 1964. She has taught English for several years in Montana schools and is currently an English language arts specialist and liaison to county school superintendents for the state Office of Public Instruction.

Susan A. Talbot - Talbot received a bachelor's degree in 1952 from Radcliffe College, and a master's degree in 1980 from the University of Montana. She has taught French at Billings Senior High School, Eastern Montana College and Missoula Hellgate High School. Talbot has served as president of the Billings Symphony Women's Association, a member of the Missoula Symphony Board of Directors, a member and president of the St. Patrick Hospital auxiliary board, a member and committee chairman of the United Way Board of Missoula and vice-president and president of the Missoula Youth Homes Board.

She is reappointed to serve a term ending February 1, 1988.

Beatrice C. McCarthy - McCarthy, a native Montanan, graduated from Rosary High School of Bozeman in 1953 and received a bachelor's degree in elementary education from Montana State University in 1957. She has completed graduate courses for teacher certification renewal at Western Montana College, Montana College of Mineral Science and Technology and the University of Montana. McCarthy began teaching in 1957 in Anaconda, and is currently teaching first grade at the Washington School in Anaconda. She is a member of the Montana Federation of Teachers, has served on the

local central labor council, the AWARE Board of Directors and was a Deer Lodge County delegate to the Governor's White House Conference on Children and Youth in 1981. McCarthy succeeds Lewy Evans, Jr., Billings.

Darla J. Keck - Keck, a junior at Northern Montana College, is a secondary education major. A Havre High School graduate, Keck was active in speech and debate and won second place in debate at the State AA Speech Tournament in both 1979 and 1980. She is a member of the Montana Higher Education Student Assistance Corporation, the National Forensic League, the governing board of the Baptist Church and the National Honor Society.

Keck is reappointed to serve as the student representative on the board and will serve a term ending February 1, 1984.


