

MINUTES OF MEETING OF THE
SENATE RULES COMMITTEE
APRIL 19th, 1983

The twelfth meeting of the Senate Rules Committee was called to order by Chairman, Frank W. Hazelbaker, at 2:14 P.M. on April 19th, 1983, in Room 331 of the Capitol Building. All members were present.

HOUSE BILLS No. 926 and No. 927:

These bills are before the Senate Rules Committee because they came over late from the House.

Senator Jean Turnage moved that the Committee recommend that the bills not be accepted by the Senate because they do not comply with the Joint Rules. With Senator Tom Towe voting No and all other Senators of the Committee voting Yes, the motion passed.

SENATE BILL No. SB 452:


Senator Hazelbaker pointed out that the House had added an amendment to the bill, adding an appropriation which amendment does not fall within the Joint Rules.

Senator Turnage moved that the Amendment to Senate Bill No. 452 is not in accordance with the Joint Rules and that the bill be returned to the House. With all members voting Aye, the motion passed unanimously.

HOUSE BILL No. HB 833:

Senator Turnage moved that the Chairman of the Rules Committee recommend to the Senate that the rules be temporarily suspended in order that House Bill 833 may be accepted by the Senate. All members voting Aye, the motion carried.

The meeting adjourned at 2:28 P.M. on the same day.
