HOUSE BILL NO. 1: The hearing commenced on House Bill No. 1. Representative Francis Bardanouve, sponsor of the bill, stated the bill is the "feed bill" for the session. He stated the bill is based on a ten day special session and presented the committee with a budget comparison based on previous special sessions (Exhibit #1).

The meeting of the Finance and Claims Committee was called to order by Chairman Matt Himsel on December 15, 1983, at 1:30 p.m. in Room 108 of the State Capitol Building.

ROLL CALL: Roll was called with all members present with the exception of Senator Harold Dover, who was absent.

CONSIDERATION OF HOUSE BILL 10: This bill is an act extending the payment date of a loan to the Department of Health and Environmental Sciences to fund subdivision review; and providing an immediate effective date. Senator Pat Regan of Senate District 31, a co-sponsor of the bill, presented the bill to the committee. She stated that the Department had already repaid the loan which was given to them earlier, however, they are now without operating money.

Mr. Bill Gosney, representing the Department of Administration stood in support of the bill. He stated that this bill would allow the Department to continue to review the subdivisions.

With no further proponents, Chairman Himsel called on the opponents. Hearing none, the meeting was opened to a question and answer period from the Committee.

ACTION: A motion was made by Senator Story that House Bill 10 receive a recommendation of BE CONCURRED IN from the Committee. Motion carried with all members present voting "yes" with the exception of Senator Boylan who voted "no".
