MINUTES OF THE MEFTINGS RULES COMMITTEE

January 7, 1985

PURPOSE OF MEETING: Chairman Ramirez turned the meeting over to Vice Chairman Harper for the purpose of discussing House Resolution 1.

A lengthy discussion ensued pertaining to the Conference Committee reports. When the bill goes back to the Senate and comes out on a vote of 2 to 1 it will go back to the House without recommendation. It was the feeling that the Senate has been given full power when it comes to conference committees.

Rep. Keyser mentioned the Conference Committee members meet with the Senate and really don't make any report until two members of the Senate Committee agree. Once it comes to the floor you still have to have action taken. If the Senate does not agree it comes back without recommendation.

Rep. Quilici mentioned if it comes out with no recommendation you still have to get a majority vote by the full House.

Rep. Harper spoke on the tie vote problem and would be submitted to the House without recommendation.

Rep. Keyser said the Senate cannot receive our committee report until we go back and the House acts on it. He then moved to amend HJR-1 as follows:
