The purpose of the meeting was to discussed House Rule H1-5 which states if motions "do pass" and "do not pass" or "indefinitely postpone" both fail on Second Reading, a motion to reconsider is in order in Committee of the Whole.


Bob Person, Legislative Council had prepared three options which would take care of the problem, which were then passed out to committee members.

A brief discussion ensued by members of the committee and Rep. Marks moved the following:

"If the motions "do pass" and either "do not pass" or "indefinitely postpone" both fail on Second Reading, a motion to reconsider is in order in Committee of the Whole. If a motion to reconsider then fails, the bill shall be reported to the House as having failed to pass Second Reading."

Rep. Harper seconded the motion, passed unanimously.

Rep. Keyser moved the meeting adjourn at 5:55 p.m. Carried unanimously.

DO PASS

H1-5 as is:

If the motions "do pass" and "do not pass" or "indefinitely postpone" both fail on Second Reading, a motion to reconsider is in order in Committee of the Whole.

Option 1:

If the motions "do pass", and "do not pass", or and "indefinitely postpone" ~~both~~ all fail on Second Reading, a motion to reconsider is in order in Committee of the Whole. If a motion to reconsider then fails, the bill shall be reported to the House as having failed to pass Second Reading.

Option 2:

If the motions "do pass" and "do not pass" ~~or~~ "~~indefinitely postpone~~" both fail on Second Reading, ~~a motion to reconsider is in order in Committee of the Whole~~ the bill shall be reported to the House as having failed to pass Second Reading.

Option 3:

If the motions "do pass", ~~and~~ "do not pass", ~~or~~ and "indefinitely postpone" ~~both~~ all fail on Second Reading, ~~a motion to reconsider is in order in Committee of the Whole~~ the bill shall be reported to the House as having failed to pass Second Reading.
