

MINUTES OF THE MEETING
AGRICULTURE COMMITTEE
MONTANA STATE
HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

January 25, 1985

The meeting of the Agriculture Committee was called to order by Chairman Schultz on January 25, 1985 at 3:15 p.m. in Room 317 of the State Capitol.

ROLL CALL: All members were present.

Chairman Schultz turned the committee over to Vice-Chairperson Holliday.

CONSIDERATION OF HOUSE BILL NO. 350: Rep. Schultz, sponsor of the bill, stated that this bill would clarify the fact that all applicant fees, including registration fees, would be nonrefundable. This fee would cover application review costs incurred by the department. This would also clarify what information is required when applying for a permit or registration. (Exhibit A attached hereto)

PROPOSERS: Keith Kelly from the Department of Agriculture, stated that the department supports this bill.

There being no further proponents or opponents to the bill, Representative Schultz closed.

DISCUSSION OF HOUSE BILL NO. 350: Representative Cody asked Mr. Kelly what happens to the \$25 fee. Mr. Kelly informed her that a part of it goes to the cost to run the program, a portion of it goes to the general fund and the other portion goes to the laboratory.

There were no further questions. Vice-Chairperson Holliday closed the hearing and Representative Schultz assumed the chair.

DISPOSITION OF HOUSE BILL NO. 350: Rep. Jenkins made a motion to DO PASS House Bill No. 350. Rep. Fritz seconded the motion. House Bill No. 350 PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.

DISPOSITION OF HOUSE BILL NO. 233: Rep. Patterson moved that House Bill No. 233 DO PASS AS AMENDED. Rep. Fritz seconded. House Bill No. 233 PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.

ADJOURN: There being no further business before the committee, the meeting was adjourned at 3:30 p.m.

Section I

Section 80-9-201

Permits and Registrations

The proposed change in Section 80-9-201 (1) would clarify the fact that all applicant fees, including registration fees, would be nonrefundable. The nonrefundable applicant fee would cover application review costs incurred by the Department.

The proposed change in Section 80-9-201 (2) would clarify what information is required when applying for a permit or registration. The Department now has to seek additional information relative to labels or facsimiles. The proposed change would enhance the Department's ability to review all information.
