

MINUTES OF THE MEETING

The meeting of the Rules Committee was called to order by Rep. Jack Ramirez, Chairman on February 26, 1985 at 3:20 p.m. in the House Appropriations Committee room, State Capitol.

ROLL CALL: Roll was called with Reps. Addy and Quilici absent.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss House Bill 923 which is an attempt to get control of the space in the Capitol back into the hands of the legislature.


Bob Person, Legislative Council stated that the current responsibility is vested in the Department of Administration. He then briefly explained each section of the bill. He mentioned one of the things the committee might want to consider is to contract with the Department of Administration on various aspects such as the security and cleaning of the building.

Dave Ashley from the Department of Administration spoke briefly on what their responsibilities involve concerning the Capitol Building.

Committee members then discussed at some length how the space might be divided in the building in regard to legislative office space.

Rep. Jack Moore moved that House Bill 923 do pass. Seconded and passed unanimously.
