CONSIDERATION OF SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 4: Representative Ellerd, District #77, co-sponsor of the resolution, appeared and offered testimony. He read the resolution to the committee. He then stated that Larry's father became the brand inspector and Rep. Ellerd got to know him and Larry very well. 
