MINUTES OF THE MEETING FISH AND GAME COMMITTEE MONTANA STATE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

March 21, 1985

A special meeting of the Fish and Game Committee was called to order by Chairman Ream on March 21, 1985, at 11:30 a.m. in room 317 of the State Capitol.

ROLL CALL: All committee members were present with the exception of Representative Ellison.

EXECUTIVE SESSION: Representative Cobb moved to reconsider Senate Bill No. 255. Representative Jenkins seconded the motion. Question was called. Representative Cobb made a motion to remove the amendment on the Augusta Preserve. Representative Grady seconded the motion.

Representative Rapp-Svrcek wanted to know why this motion was being made. Mr. Cogley, the researcher, said they had a problem with the legal description. He said that the Augusta Preserve has been taken off the books as a special area, so this amendment had to be removed. More committee discussion followed.

Question was called on the amendment removal motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Representative Cobb made a DO PASS motion on Senate Bill No. 255. Question was called. The motion carried with the dissenting votes of Representatives Cobb, Grady, and Hanson.

SENATE BILL NO. 371: Representative Cobb made a motion to reconsider Senate Bill No. 371. Representative Jenkins seconded the motion. Dave Cogley distributed a copy of the proposed amendments to all committee members. (See Exhibit No. 1) He explained the amendments to the committee. Committee discussion followed.

Representative Rapp-Svrcek made a motion to adopt the amendments. Question was called on the amendments. The motion passed with the dissenting vote of Representative Grady.

Representative Phillips made a DO PASS AS AMENDED motion on Senate Bill No. 371. Representative Jenkins seconded the motion. Question was called. The motion passed unanimously.

Jim Flynn, Director of the Department of Fish, Wildlife, and Parks, appeared before the committee to report on the letter sent to the House Appropriations committee by this committee. He said that it had a positive effect, because they reinstated the money as a result of the letter.

ADJOURNMENT: There being no further business before the committee, the meeting was adjourned at 11:45.
