### MINUTES OF THE MEETING APPROPRIATIONS COMMITTEE MONTANA STATE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

April 1, 1985

The meeting of the Appropriations Committee was called to order by Chairman Bardanouve on April 1, 1985 in Room 104 of the State Capitol.

ROLL CALL: All members were present except Representative Donaldson, who was absent, and Representative Quilici, who was excused.

(Tape 78:A:000)

HOUSE BILL 955: "AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO DANIELS COUNTY TO REIMBURSE THE COUNTY FOR REFUNDS OF CORPORATE LICENSE TAXES."

Representative Nathe (004) asked the Department of Revenue to speak on his bill.

Dan Bucks, Deputy Director, Operations, Department of Revenue, said the department does not oppose the idea of reimbursing Daniels County, but does oppose the idea of reimbursing one county when the majority of counties statewide have lost revenue because of the changes in the law on paying bank taxation in the neighborhood of \$2 million. He said Daniels County believes that because they paid, by choice, a refund on amended returns as opposed to offsetting that claim for a refund against future taxes, this method of payment has resulted in Daniels County losing money they otherwise would not have been liable for. The fact is that if they had chosen the other option, that bank had a valid claim for that refund and this claim has to be paid regardless of the method of payment. Dan Bucks said the source of the problem is not the decision made at the county level or the advice given to Daniels County by the department, but the changing nature of the bank tax law which resulted in 1982 when

The 1983 Legislature adopted a formula approach to try to make up the lost revenue for local governments and that formula approach made up most of the revenue, but except not quite. It left local governments with 8 to 10 percent less money statewide on the average than they had before. Burlington Northern took the 1983 law to court and said it was invalid under the 1982 court decision. The Montana Supreme Court agreed that the law was invalid under the 1982 decision, but they said the 1982 decision was wrong. Dan Bucks said when the Department of Revenue reads the 1984 decision, any returns filed before the date of November, 1984 would be treated under the former law - the 1983 law - and any returns filed, amended or otherwise, after that decision would be treated under the 1979 law.

Dan Bucks said Daniels County is not unique, but this is Daniels County piece of the \$2 million revenue loss.

Representative Bardanouve (054) asked if this claim is paid, would it set a precedent for all the rest of the \$2 million. Dan Bucks said he thinks the Legislature would have to judge whether this would be a precedent, but in his mind it would be a precedent. Representative Nathe closed on his bill.

### EXECUTIVE ACTION

Representative Hand (173) made a motion the House Bill 955 Do Pass. Representative Menahan made a substitute motion that House Bill 955 Do Not Pass. Representative Moore made an amendatory motion that House Bill 955 be TABLED. A roll call vote was taken and the motion carried, with Representatives Lory, Manuel, Miller, Nathe abstaining; and the proxy vote of Representative Quilici was yes.

HOUSE BILL 952: "AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE SELECT COMMITTEE ON WATER MARKETING TO FURTHER THE DEVELOPMENT OF A COMPREHENSIVE WATER POLICY FOR MONTANA."

Representative Bradley (245) is carrying the bill for the bill's sponsor, Representative Iverson. She presented some proposed amendments to the bill (See Standing Committee Report in these Minutes).

#### EXECUTIVE ACTION

Representative Bradley (386) made a motion the amendments be accepted (EXHIBIT 1). A voice vote was taken and the motion carried unanimously.

Representative Bradley made a motion that House Bill 952

AS AMENDED DO PASS. A roll call vote was taken and the motion carried, with Representatives Hand, Manuel, Moore, Thoft and Waldron voting no.

Adjourn: The meeting adjourned.
