# MINUTES OF THE MEETING GENERAL GOVERNMENT AND HIGHWAYS SUBCOMMITTEE MONIANA STATE JOINT SUBCOMMITTEE

January 21, 1985

The meeting of the General Government and Highways Subcommittee was called to order by Chairman Quilici on January 21, 1985 at 9:00 a.m. in Room 437 of the State Capitol.

ROLL CALL: All members were present with the exception of Senator Stimatz. Also present were Don Witmer and Cliff Roessner from the LFA Office, and Doug Booker from the Governor's Office.

#### LEGISLATIVE BRANCH

Office of the Legislative Auditor: Robert R. Ringwood, Legislative Auditor. stated that they didn't ask for increases over last year's budget, and discussed the figures (20;A;11). C. D. Avery then presented the budget for the agency (20;A;22). He went over the budget found on Exhibit No. 1. The agency is requesting 65 FTEs, which is the same number requested and approved in the last biennium. The underlying reasons for increase of staffing were the change in audit frequency and the new statewide audit. There was discussion on the seven positions that were left vacant over the entire 1984 fiscal year, and the need for all of the authorized positions. Other issues discussed were the computer system the agency requested, the increase in out-of-state travel, and contingencies.

Senator Gage asked why there was about \$25,000 difference in the contracted services. There is actually \$50,000, which \$25,000 is for the study of requirements and definition of system needs. The other \$20,000 in question is for audit contracts contingencies, and \$5,000 for technical services they regularly need for audit processes (20;A;229).

Senator Keating asked if they got behind in their work because of the seven vacant positions. C. D. Avery said that they have to average the 65 FTEs to get their work done (20;A;276).

There was also dicussion on the funding of the agency from the General Fund and the Legislative Audit Fund.

Tom Romero, Certified Public Accountant, Management Consultant, gave his view on the staffing issue. He felt that with the Central Audit, the number of hours that might be charged to the individual agencies audit would be reduced because the work would be done for the Central Audit already. This would also reduce the number of adjustments they would have to make at the agency level. The agency had also gotten into the Statewide audit with the reduced level of staff, all of this led him to believe that there could be a slight over staffing at this point (20;B;51).

Mr. Ringwood, also stated that the agency is doing more audits themselves, which means they are doing less contracting then they use to do. This adds into their total hours (20;B;156).

<u>Legislative Council</u>: Diana Dowling, Executive Director, went over the budget requests for all the divisions, found on Exhibit No. 2. She explained all the figures and what they included (2;B;210). Exhibit No. 3 is a summary of all the divisions budgets.

ADJOURN: There being no further business before the committee, the meeting was adjourned at 12:10 p.m.
