

MINUTES OF THE MEETING
EDUCATION AND CULTURAL RESOURCES COMMITTEE
MONTANA STATE SENATE

MARCH 29, 1985

The 27th meeting of the Senate Education and Cultural Resources Committee was called to order by the Chairman, Senator Chet Blaylock, at 12:30 p.m. in Room 402, Capitol Building.

ROLL CALL: All committee members were present.

FURTHER CONSIDERATION OF HOUSE BILL 497:

REPRESENTATIVE KOEHNKE, sponsor, introduced Jim Moulds, Superintendent of Centerville Schools, who reviewed the existing tuition law for the committee. He presented a survey of all the schools in the state (Exhibit #1) which shows wide support for the bill.

TOM LARANG, Chairman of the Board of Trustees, Centerville, told the committee they can't pay tuition for all the students who want to go to Great Falls. He felt it would force them to close the schools if they did.

ACTION ON HOUSE BILL 497:

SENATOR FARRELL moved HOUSE BILL 497 be moved off the table for further consideration. The motion CARRIED unanimously.

SENATOR MAZUREK moved to amend HOUSE BILL 497 as per the attached standing committee report. The motion CARRIED unanimously.

SENATOR HAFLEY moved HOUSE BILL 497 BE CONCURRED IN AS AMENDED. The motion CARRIED with Senator Regan voting no.

ACTION ON HOUSE BILL 18:

SENATOR MAZUREK moved HOUSE BILL 18 BE CONCURRED IN. The motion CARRIED on a roll call vote (Exhibit #2).

ADJOURN: There being no further business to come before the committee, the meeting was adjourned.
