

MINUTES OF THE MEETING
FREE CONFERENCE COMMITTEE
SENATE BILL 54

April 17, 1985

The meeting of the Free Conference Committee on Senate Bill 54 was called to order by the Chairman, Senator Thomas Towe at 11:06 a.m. in Room 415 of the State Capitol.

ROLL CALL: Those members present were Senator Thomas Towe, Senator Joe Mazurek, Representative Toni Bergene, Representative Ralph Eudaily and Representative Gary Spaeth. Those absent were Senator Jack Galt and Representative Joan Miles.

The Chairman called on Mr. Charles Briggs, State Agency Coordinator, Governor's Office, who stated the necessity of protecting the elderly (over 60) from abuse or neglect. He stated that even able bodied older persons could be neglected or taken advantage of and these persons should also be protected.

The motion was made to reinsert on Page 1, line 7 of the title the word "CERTAIN" and strike the word "A" following the word "EXPLOIT".

Question was called. MOTION CARRIED unanimously.

The motion was made to insert on Page 1, line 17 following the word "authority" the words "Without lawful authority."


Question was called. MOTION CARRIED with Representative Bergene voting NO, all others voting yes.

The motion was made to strike on Page 2, line 12 the words [THIS ACT] following "under" and insert "53-5-525(2)".

Question was called. MOTION CARRIED unanimously.

It was noted that Representative Miles wanted to be recorded as voting yes on all of the above proposed amendments.
