MINUTES OF THE MEETING TAXATION COMMITTEE MONTANA STATE SENATE

April 24, 1985

The eightieth meeting of the Senate Taxation Committee was called to order by Chairman Thomas E. Towe at 8:12 am in Room 413-415 of the State Capitol.

ROLL CALL: All members were present at roll call except Senator Hirsch who arrived at 8:17 and Senator McCallum who arrived at 8:30.

MOTION: Senator Lybeck moved that Chairman Towe actively pursue adequate ventilation for the room before the beginning of the next session. Question was not called, but the Chairman and other members agreed that the point was well taken.

CONSIDERATION OF HJR 9: Exhibit 1 was a balance sheet from which the numbers in HJR 9 could be amended. Senator Towe discussed the nature of the differences and said that amendments to the resolution had been prepared to make it agree with the numbers from the Governor's Office of Budget and Program Planning.

Senator Mazurek noted that collections from the additional auditors for the Department of Revenue were not included by OBPP. Mr. Terry Johnson of that office said that was an insurance factor to be certain that the estimates made were solid. He said that to budget on audit collections is too great a risk.

Senator Halligan asked about SB 72. Senator Towe said it had been amended to handle the joint return problem.

Senator Hager asked about the \$4.9 million figure assigned to the bill. Mr. Johnson said that accounted for '85 receipts and that the fiscal note as amended was high because the railroad tier retirement was not included in the original note on the bill. Senator Hager said that he could accept a \$3.1 million figure with no retroactive clause on the bill.

In response to a question from Senator Lybeck, Senator Eck said that various amendments on SB 431 would result in different numbers being used.

Senator Towe then presented the committee with Exhibit 2.

Senator Mazurek said that he was tempted to move all the Governor's figures into the bill. Senator Eck said she agreed, but that she wanted to know the reasons for the differences. Senator Towe discussed those differences.

(Senators Halligan and McCallum were excused at 8:47 am to attend a conference committee meeting.)

MOTION: Senator Mazurek moved that HJR 9 be amended per Exhibit 3.

Senator Towe noted that the Westmoreland law suit escrow account numbers were not included here. Senator Towe also said that his own figures were more accurate than OBPP's simply because they had been more recently updated.

Senator Eck said she wanted the record to note that the anticipated \$9 to \$11 million from the audit collections was not included.

Question was called on the amendments and the motion carried unanimously.

MOTION: Senator Mazurek moved that HJR 9 be concurred in as amended.

MOTION: Senator Eck moved that HJR 9 be amended to add an additional "Be it further resolved," to include the audit collections from the Department of Revenue.

Mr. Johnson noted that cash flow was another problem in counting these collections as there was no way to estimate when the money would actually be received.

Question was called and the motion to amend carried unanimously.

Question on the resolution was called and the $\underline{\text{motion carried}}$ unanimously.

Chairman Towe adjourned the meeting.
