

MONTANA STATE SENATE  
JUDICIARY COMMITTEE  
MINUTES OF THE MEETING

March 29, 1986

The eighth meeting of the Senate Judiciary Committee for the 49th Second Special Session was called to order at 6:00 P.M. on March 29, 1986, by Chairman Joe Mazurek in Room 325 of the Capitol Building.

ROLL CALL: All committee members were present.

ACTION ON SB 12: Senator Mazurek explained that when we incorporated Representative Bardanouve's language, which is contained in amendments numbered 4 and 5, that because of the structure of this bill that we could reimpose sovereign immunity by majority but to limit compensatory damage it would require a two-thirds vote. Because of this, Senator Mazurek made a motion that SB 12 be returned to committee to reconsider the action adopted by the committee. The motion carried unanimously.

Senator Towe made a motion to amend SB 12 on page 3, line 12, to say "A law imposing immunity from suit or" to deal with the problem outlined by Senator Mazurek. This would change amendment number 6 in the attached Exhibit 1.

Senator Mazurek said this would insure that the legislature could not impose immunity from suit without a two-thirds vote of each house.

The motion carried with a vote of 9-1. Senator Shaw was opposed to the motion.

Senator Towe made a motion that the bill DO PASS AS AMENDED. The motion passed with a vote of 6-4. See attached Roll Call Vote sheet.
