MINUTES OF THE MEETING HUMAN SERVICES AND AGING COMMITTEE 50TH LEGISLATIVE SESSION HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

January 8, 1987

The meeting of the Human Services and Aging Committee was called to order by Chairman R. Budd Gould on January 8, 1987, at 1:02 p.m. in Room 312-D of the State Capitol.

ROLL CALL: All members were present with the exception of Rep. Cody who was excused.

REP. GOULD noted that since the meeting time had been cut short on Tuesday because of a caucus being scheduled, and there hadn't been time for any orientation, if the committee had any questions, he would be glad to answer them at this time. No questions were offered at this time.

REP. GRINDE questioned whether any further information had been obtained from SRS regarding the number of recipients receiving benefits who were injured in motorcycle accidents. Chairman Gould stated they had not received anything from SRS concerning that.

EXECUTIVE SESSION - ACTION ON HOUSE BILL # 24:

REP. GILBERT stated for the purpose of discussion, he would move that HB # 24 DO PASS.

COMMITTEE DISCUSSION:

REP. CORNE' reported that in the statistics he had from Rep. Nisbet, which came from the SRS office, they state that in 1985 there were 232 incapacitating motorcycle accidents in Montana. Rep. Kitselman inquired if Rep. Corne' had any dollar value or any time frame for the payments. To which Rep. Corne' replied he did not have that information. Chairman Gould asked Rep. Corne' if he had any statistics on the percentage of people who were wearing helmets of the 232 who were injured. Rep. Corne' stated he did not have that answer.

REP. KITSELMAN made a substitute motion that the bill be tabled in order to make certain that everyone has time to discuss it.

REP. NELSON wanted the record to show that he felt the press did a gross disservice to those who do a consciencious job of trying to make their motorcycle riding safe by wearing helmets and providing for themselves, by publishing the picture in the newspaper that they did.

REP. SIMON said he would like to have the committee make a formal request to the SRS to supply them with statistics regarding what the cost is to the taxpayers for the care of people who have been injured in motorcycle accidents, and don't have the necessary insurance. Chairman Gould stated that would be determined by the action of the committee today.

REP. KITSELMAN stated that without objection, he would make the motion to table HB # 24.

CHAIRMAN GOULD called for a roll call vote. The motion CARRIED with 15 favorable and 2 opposing votes. He then stated that the bill was tabled and it would take a simple majority vote to bring it off the table.

CHAIRMAN GOULD then informed the committee that the Tuesday meeting would be held a 1:00 p.m. instead of 12:30 p.m. to consider HB # 74 and HB # 75. He also noted that HB # 82, sponsored by Jan Brown, was re-referred to the Judiciary Committee along with four companion bills.

REP. SIMON questioned who would be obtaining additional information from SRS, or if he should do it. Chairman Gould commended Rep. Simon for volunteering to go to SRS and get further information. At this point Chairman Gould entertained a motion for adjournment.

ADJOURNMENT: Rep. Gilbert moved to adjourn. The motion CARRIED unanimously. The meeting was adjourned at 1:16 p.m.
