MINUTES OF THE MEETING EDUCATION AND CULTURAL RESOURCES COMMITTEE MONTANA STATE SENATE

January 19, 1987

The fourth meeting of the Senate Education and Cultural Resources Committee was called to order by the Chairman, Senator Bob Brown, at 1:25 p.m. in Room 402, State Capitol Building.

ROLL CALL: All committee members were present.

ACTION ON SENATE BILL 37: SENATOR NEUMAN MOVED SENATE BILL 37 DO NOT PASS. The motion CARRIED with Senator Regan voting no and Senator Smith absent.

ACTION ON SENATE BILL 38: SENATOR REGAN MOVED to adopt the proposed amendments to the bill (prepared by Betsy Griffing, Committee Counsel, Exhibit #1).

SENATOR McCALLUM asked if this would change the intent of the bill.

SENATOR BROWN said it does not change a thing. It simply allows a gradual evening out of PI days so schools get an even one ANB per school day. He said it is a phase out way of doing what Senator Williams wants to do all at once.

SENATOR MAZUREK said it is obvious something needs to be done, but it is not right to cut them off at the knees. This is a good middle ground.

SENATOR HAMMOND said he fears if we go one more year, all the schools who don't have extra PI days at present will suddenly up their days.

SENATOR MAZUREK MOVED to amend the amendment by inserting "and each ensuing school fiscal year " following "year" on line 11, sub-paragraph (2). The motion <u>CARRIED</u> with Senators Neuman and Smith absent.

SENATOR HAMMOND MOVED to amend the amendment to reflect two days rather than one day. He said he proposed the amendment because of schools who are on short rations because of the gradual one day phase out.

SENATOR REGAN felt the two day amendment would hurt some schools badly. She said fiscally it would equal ten teachers salaries in Billings.

SENATOR BLAYLOCK pointed out some small schools are getting two to three times per student what the big schools are. He said the disparity exists in many areas.

THE HAMMOND MOTION FAILED ON A ROLL CALL VOTE (Exhibit #2).

A ROLL CALL VOTE was taken on Senator Regan's motion to adopt the amendment (as amended). The motion CARRIED (Exhibit #3).

SENATOR MAZUREK moved SB 38 DO PASS AS AMENDED. Senator Hammond indicated he would like to try to further amend the bill as Senators Smith and Neuman were now present.

SENATOR MAZUREK WITHDREW HIS MOTION.

SENATOR HAMMOND moved to reconsider the action adopting the two day amendment which previously failed. The motion DIED ON A TIE ROLL CALL VOTE (Exhibit #4).

SENATOR MAZUREK moved SB 38 DO PASS AS AMENDED. The motion CARRIED with Senator Neuman voting no.

ACTION ON SENATE BILL 39: SENATOR MAZUREK moved SB 39 DO NOT PASS. The motion FAILED ON A TIE ROLL CALL VOTE (Exhibit #5).

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
