#### SUBCOMMITTEE ON GENERAL GOVERNMENT AND HIGHWAYS

Call to Order: By Chairman Quilici, on January 13, 1989, at 8:06 a.m.

Announcements/Discussion: Rep. Quilici announced the session would adjourn at 11:00 today due to the State of the State address and House caucuses.

#### DISPOSITION OF DISTRICT COURTS

Tape No. 13A

- Motion: Sen. Regan moved to accept LFA current level for district courts.
- Amendments, Discussion, and Votes: The motion PASSED unanimously.
- Motion: Sen Regan moved to grant the difference of \$4683 and \$7883 in 91.
- <u>Discussion:</u> Discussion regarding travel expenses in relation to the motion followed.
- Amendments, Discussion, and Votes: The motion PASSED with Rep. Swysgood and Sen. Tveit voting nay.

## DISPOSITION OF STATE AUDITOR'S OFFICE: CENTRAL MANAGEMENT DIVISION

Tape No. 13A

- Motion: Rep. Swysgood moved to accept LFA current level.
- Amendments, Discussion, and Votes: The motion PASSED unanimously.
- Motion: Sen Stimatz moved to accept the modified request for audit staff at \$59,076 in FY90 and \$51,839 in FY91 and the computer system upgrade at \$14,640 in FY90 and \$14,640 in FY91.
- Discussion: Discussion regarding the computer system followed. Committee members asked for someone to address the need for the 2 FTE audit staff. Andy Bennett addressed the issue. There was discussion regarding the need to do the audits which would require the additional FTE. It was decided to put the issues on hold.

### DISPOSITION OF STATE AUDITOR'S OFFICE: AUDIT DIVISION

Tape No. 13A

- Motion: Rep. Swysgood moved to accept the executive budget.
- Discussion: Discussion regarding the differences between the LFA and executive budgets followed.
- Amendments, Discussion, and Votes: Sen. Regan amended the motion to accept the executive budget and add one FTE.
  - Discussion regarding FTE followed.
  - The motion as amended PASSED with Rep. Nisbet and Sen. Stimatz voting nay.
- Motion: Sen. Regan moved to use the state special revenue account funding as recommended in the LFA current level budget (\$15,630).
- Discussion: Rep. Quilici asked for clarification. Clayton Schenck explained both the LFA and executive budgets use the same funding level but the LFA uses the balance

- of a special revenue account so it uses less general fund. The motion before the committee would not change the level of appropriation.
- Amendments, Discussion, and Votes: The motion PASSED unanimously.
- Motion: Sen Tveit moved to approved the modified request for remodeling for the new warrant system. (\$41,989 for FY90 and \$1000 for FY91)
- Amendments, Discussion, and Votes: The motion PASSED unanimously.
- Motion: Sen. Regan moved to approve converting the P/P/P system to on-line at the cost of \$204,000 in FY90 only.
- <u>Discussion:</u> Discussion followed regarding the eventual elimination of FTE as a result of the conversion.
- Amendments, Discussion, and Votes: The motion PASSED unanimously.

## DISPOSITION OF STATE AUDITOR'S OFFICE: INSURANCE DIVISION

Tape No. 13B

- Motion: Sen. Regan moved to accept LFA current level.
- Amendments, Discussion, and Votes: The motion PASSED unanimously.
- Motion: Sen. Regan moved to approve the actuarial position at a salary of \$60,000 per year.
- Discussion: Rep. Quilici presented some salaries of actuaries in states around Montana. The motion was clarified so the committee understood this would not add \$60,000 to the amount already appropriated in LFA current level, but instead would bring the total salary to \$60,000 plus benefits.
- Amendments, Discussion, and Votes: The motion PASSED unanimously.
- Motion: Sen. Tweit moved to approve 2 field investigators, 1 examiner, 1 attorney and 1 Administrative Aide (approximately half of the requested 9 additional FTE).

- <u>Discussion:</u> Discussion followed regarding the need for additional staff in this area.
- Amendments, Discussion, and Votes: The motion PASSED with Sen. Regan and Rep. Swysgood voting nay.

# DISPOSITION OF STATE AUDITOR'S OFFICE: SECURITIES DIVISION

- Motion: Rep. Nisbet moved to accept LFA current level budget.
- <u>Discussion:</u> The differences between LFA and executive budgets were discussed.
- Amendments, Discussion, and Votes: The motion PASSED unanimously.
