DISPOSITION OF SENATE BILL 179

Motion: Rep. Wallin moved BE CONCURRED IN and moved the amendment.

Discussion: Rep. Wallin went over his amendments to SB 179. Instead of requiring a high school diploma, require at least 2 years of high school or GED, and change the title.

Rep. Blotkamp asked what a GED is equivalent to. Rep. Johnson said it would be equivalent to a diploma.

Paul said the title as he understands it would now read "requiring 2 years of high school or the equivalent of a high school diploma for licensure". Rep. Johnson asked the lady from the office of public instruction if this is right? The representative said the GED is given in lieu of completion of high school or the eighth grade. The GED is administered through the office of public instruction and is a very simple thing to do. It is recognized as an equivalent to the high school diploma but it is not the same time.

Rep. Bachini asked if with the amendment would it be contradictory? The representative said they are two separate things, they either have 2 years of high school or the GED.

Amendments, Discussion, and Votes: The amendments DO PASS.

HEARING ON SENATE BILL 175

Presentation and Opening Statement by Sponsor:

Sen. Beck, Senate District 24, here today to present to you a total of 4 bills, starting with SB 175. This bill will provide a procedure to enable a person harmed by the unlawful conduct of a licensed motor vehicle dealer to take action against the dealer's required bond.

Proponent Testimony:

Mr. Funk said that Sen. Beck introduced this bill at the department's request. On page 4, line 17, the existing language regarding the dealer bond. It simply says that the purpose is to protect against the unlawful operation by motor vehicle dealers. The reason we are proposing the change is to clarify the procedure under which a person could collect against that bond. What we are proposing is a process which will specify what a person has to do when they are harmed in this situation.

Closing by Sponsor: Sen. Beck said that this type of legislation would not be used very often. It is a consumer protection bill and I ask your support of this bill.

HEARING ON SENATE BILL 298

Presentation and Opening Statement by Sponsor:

Sen. Farrell, Senate District 31. The purpose of long-term care insurance act is to establish minimum standards as to what can be sold in Montana as long-term care insurance. Long-term care definition in the bill means insurance which provides inpatient health coverage for not less than 12 consecutive months in a facility other than the acute care unit of a hospital. This type of coverage is commonly referred to as nursing home coverage. Our state currently has no minimum standards for this type of coverage.

Proponent Testimony:

Ms. Witte stated that this bill is based on the national association of insurance commissioners model which was amended in December of 1988. Montana currently has no minimum standards for this type of long-term health care coverage or nursing home coverage. This bill basically spells out what long-term care policies should provide. It is a good consumer bill, it is a good disclosure bill, and I hope the committee gives it a do pass recommendation.

Questions From Committee Members: Rep. Simon asked Ms. Witte if she was aware of the amendments. She said the department worked with Mr. Hopgood on the amendments.

HEARING ON SENATE BILLS 365 & 366

Presentation and Opening Statement by Sponsor:

Sen. Beck, Senate District 24, said he would like to do both 365 and 366 at the same time as they are companion bills. These bills are companion measures that provide mechanisms for liens to be filed on snowmobiles and boats for security interests. The statutes currently provide for the lien filings on all titled vehicles such as cars, trucks, motorcycles, and trailers, but don't allow for snowmobiles

and boats. Snowmobiles and boats are often substantial investments, but there is no way for a lender to establish a lien on these. As a result lenders often file liens on other property and titled vehicles to have their lien provision secure. This will provide for the protection of or release of secured interest, a notification to owners that the lien has been filed, and the lien filing fee.

Mr. Robinson said this bill is a proposal that came from the registrar's bureau in Deer Lodge. Basically it provides the same mechanism for people who are titling their boats and snowmobiles to have a lien filed against them like cars, trailers, trucks, etc. As it is now, the lender has to get a UCC filing through the secretary of state's office. Right now we find that quite often when a person buys a boat which is a substantial investment, the bank is placing a lien on the individual's home or other titled vehicles as opposed to being able to put a lien directly on the boat.

Closing by Sponsor: Sen. Beck said he would appreciate the committee's support for these bills.

HEARING ON SENATE BILL 330

Presentation and Opening Statement by Sponsor:

Sen. Beck, Senate District 24. SB 330's general purpose is to change certain laws regulating the insurance in Montana. It is not intended to prohibit the growth of the insurance industry but to update and bring Montana's laws in line with the happenings in other states. It authorizes the commissioner of insurance to suspend or revoke an insurer's certificate of authority for failure to employ only licensed

insurance agents or failure to supervise its insurance agents. It requires holding company systems to register properly and to provide accurate information to the commissioner of insurance about their affiliated companies' transactions.

Mr. Ashebraner said State Farm supports the bill, but proposes the first portion of the bill be stricken. State Farm has no control over the agents nor the office staff the agents hire because the agents are independent contractors. We support the policy that all agents should be licensed in the state of Montana.

Ms. Terrell stated that her association supports this bill. We specifically do not support, however, Section 1 and we request that you give the bill a do pass recommendation with the exception of Section 1. We request that you delete that section from the bill.

Mr. Akey stated that his association supports the bill with the amendment.

Mr. Phillips said his association also supports the bill with the amendment.

Questions From Committee Members: Rep. Blotkamp asked Mr.

Borchardt if the agents or companies have attorneys to go through the language and interpret it? Mr. Borchardt said they do or they would not have been here in support of the bill.

Rep. Kilpatrick asked Mr. Borchardt what would happen to the bill if we amended Section 1 out? Mr. Borchardt said they would all live with it. Rep. Kilpatrick asked Sen. Beck about Section 1, the Senate did not take out the section and

undoubtedly these people must have said something in the Senate hearing, how do you feel about it? Sen. Beck said this is the first he has heard about it. It did not come up in the Senate hearing, but he has no problem with the proposed amendment.

Rep. Nelson asked Sen. Beck if they weren't just talking about lines 21 through 25 on page 2, not the whole Section 1? Sen. Beck said that could be. Paul Verdon said if you strike all of Section 1, the law will remain as it is right now.

Closing by Sponsor: Sen. Beck said he thinks there is a lot of good in the bill and if you want to amend Section 1 that is fine with me. I have no problem with this.

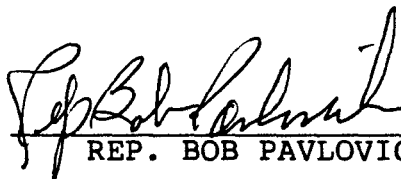

The Montana State Legislative Committee of the American Association of Retired Persons support this bill. Some of the reasons for this support are as follows: Many older persons are under the impression that the more insurance policies they have the better the coverage. Some of these folks have 5 to 10 different policies, purchased from ads on T.V. Many of these policies would not pay if another one paid, so there is no need for all the policies.

I would like to reference parts of this bill: Page 7 - section 5 - lines 7 thru 22 describe very thoroughly what this law will require. Also Page 8 Section 6 lines 13 thru 23 spell out what a company cannot do in limiting this kind of insurance. This act also allows a person time to look over his or her policy and return it if it does not meet their requirements, or what they believed it covered.

Page 12 lines 9 - 25 and page 13 lines 1 thru 16 also provide to the purchaser a complete outline of coverage.

American Association of Retired Persons strongly urges your passage of this bill.

TESTIMONY ON SENATE BILL 330
STATE AUDITOR'S OFFICE
February 9, 1989

I. Introduction

SB 330 has three parts all intended to update and bring Montana's law in line with what is happening in other states without impeding the growth and development of insurers transacting insurance in Montana. Most of SB 330 is based on models from the National Association of Insurance Commissioners (NAIC).

II. Section-by-section explanation

A. Suspension or Revocation Authority

The first section of the bill (page 2, line 4 through line 12, page 6) allows the commissioner to suspend or revoke an insurer's certificate of authority if the insurer transacts insurance in this state through an unlicensed insurance agent or fails to supervise its insurance agents reasonably to assure their compliance with the Montana Insurance Code. Providing this authority to the commissioner would make insurers transacting insurance in Montana more responsible for the actions of their agents and encourage them to employ only people who have true knowledge of the insurance products they sell.

B. Insurance Holding Company Systems

Sections 2 through 7 (page 4, line 13 through line 11, page 23) incorporate the updated version of the NAIC Insurance Holding Company System Regulatory Act. Generally, this portion of the bill requires insurance holding companies to register properly and provide accurate information to the Montana Insurance Department about their affiliated company transactions. Specifically, obsolete and vague language that never was part of a model act is deleted in section 2 (page 6, line 21 through line 7, page 7).

In section 3, on page 10, lines 20 through 25, an acquiring party is required to pay certain costs of reviewing a proposed merger or acquisition of a domestic insurer.

In section 4, language that is unique to Montana is being stricken (page 11, lines 5 through 10). The language being stricken was relied upon by Life of Montana to argue that the commissioner had no authority to review the acquisition of Life of Montana by a certain entity because the acquisition was

being effected through the transfer of "not issued and outstanding" shares. For example, if 1,000 shares were authorized and only 200 shares issued, Life of Montana argued that the remaining 800 shares (not issued and outstanding) could be issued to a single entity and control of Life of Montana thereby be transferred to the entity without prior approval of the commissioner. Judge Gordon Bennett held that such a transfer should not be allowed without approval of the commissioner, deciding the language proposed to be stricken in SB 330 had no logical meaning.

Section 5 of SB 330 (page 12, line 17 through line 20, page 16) requires an insurer which is a member of an insurance holding company system to register with the commissioner and to file an annual registration statement containing material information about the relationship between the insurer and the insurance holding company system. An insurance holding company system insurer must also notify the commissioner of changes in the information contained in the registration statement (page 15, lines 3 through 6). A person in an insurance holding company system must provide accurate information to an insurer that is subject to the holding company registration requirements (page 15, lines 16 through 20).

Subsection (1) of section 6 of SB 330 (page 16, line 21 through line 16, page 17) requires that fees and expenses charged to an insurer by its affiliate must be reasonably calculated and documented. The purpose of this requirement is to prevent an affiliate from overcharging an insurer, thereby harming policyholders. Subsection (2) of section 6 (page 17, line 17 through line 14, page 19) enumerates a list of material transactions between an insurer and an affiliate which must be reported to the commissioner 30 days in advance. The commissioner may disapprove such a transaction. Materiality is determined for each kind of transaction and each kind of insurer by setting specific thresholds. The requirement that certain transactions between insurers and affiliates be reviewed by the commissioner is intended to prevent adverse financial effects on the insurer.

Subsection (3) of section 6 (page 19, lines 15 through 22) provides that a series of similar transactions within a 12-month period are considered as a single transaction if the intent behind them was to evade review. The provision is intended to prevent circumvention of the law by an insurer which purposely structures its transactions so that they fall slightly below the thresholds set for review by the commissioner.

Subsection (4) of section 6 (page 19, line 23 through line 2, page 20) requires the commissioner's review to be keyed to whether a transaction may harm policyholders. Subsection (5) of section 6 (page 20, lines 3 through 7) require an insurer to notify the commissioner within 30 days if it has purchased more than 10% in a corporation.

Section 7 specifies a civil penalty for an insurer which fails to file a registration statement (page 21, lines 13 through

21), specifies a civil penalty for a director or officer who violates a registration statement requirement (page 21, line 22 through line 9, page 22), and permits the commissioner to stop or reverse a transaction that is not reported and is harmful to policyholders, creditors, or the public (page 22, lines 10 through 20). Without penalties in the statute, the registration statement requirements would be meaningless.

C. Credit for Reinsurance

Section 8 (page ²³~~32~~, line 12 through line 21, page 28) incorporates the updated NAIC Model Law on Credit for Reinsurance, a model act that has been adopted by many other states and has been effective in ensuring that an insurer's financial statement properly reflects the results of ceding reinsurance to a reinsurer. Specifically, the changes in subsection (2) of section 8 (page 23, lines 17 through 25) are for clarification purposes only. Subsection (3) of section 8 (page 24, line 1 through line 9, page 26) defines the circumstances under which the commissioner may grant credit for reinsurance to an alien insurer. To receive credit for reinsurance, an alien reinsurer must either (1) maintain a trust fund of at least \$20 million in the United States with a member bank of the federal reserve system and have the trustees of the fund report annually to the commissioner (page 24, line 11 through line 4, page 26); or (2) write risks that are entirely outside the United States (page 26, lines 5 through 9).

Subsection (4) (page 26, line 10 through line 6, page 27) sets forth additional conditions (related mostly to court procedure and jurisdiction) for credit for reinsurance involving a foreign or alien reinsurer that is not authorized to transact insurance in Montana.

Subsection (5) (page 27, line 7 through line 4, page 28) provides that, if a reinsurer is not licensed to transact insurance in Montana and does not meet minimum Montana financial standards, then credit for ceded reinsurance is still possible if the ceding insurer holds: (1) cash belonging to the reinsurer, (2) qualifying securities of the reinsurer, (3) clean irrevocable letters of credit issued by a federal reserve system bank, or (4) a security acceptable to the commissioner.

The main reasons for section 8 are that standards for alien reinsurers under current Montana law is too liberal in requiring an alien reinsurer simply to have an attorney-in-fact residing in the United States. Also, current Montana law on credit for reinsurance is too inflexible in not considering trusts or letters of credit in determining credit for reinsurance. In general, this portion of the bill tightens up the requirements on alien reinsurance and allows new ways of receiving credit for reinsurance.
