#### MONTANA SENATE 51st LEGISLATURE - REGULAR SESSION

#### COMMITTEE ON JUDICIARY

Call to Order: By Chairman Bruce Crippen, on February 17, 1989 at 2:00 p.m. in Room 325.

#### ROLL CALL

Members Present: Chairman Bruce Crippen, Vice Chairman Al Bishop, Senators Tom Beck, Mike Halligan, John Harp, Loren Jenkins and Senator Yellowtail.

Members Excused: Senators Joe Mazurek, and Dick Pinsoneault

Staff Present: Staff Attorney Valencia Lane and Committee Secretary Rosemary Jacoby

#### **EXECUTIVE SESSION**

#### SENATE BILL 434

<u>Discussion:</u> It was the consensus of the committee that the bill was worthy of a great deal of study and it was recommended that more research be done.

Recommendation and Vote: Senator Halligan MOVED that Senate Bill 434 BE TABLED with the stipulation that a detailed study be made during the interim and a bill be drawn up for the next session of the legislature. The entire committee agreed. Beata Galda, Department of Highways and Marcella Sherfy agreed on the worthiness of the bill's subject matter. Marcella Sherfy, State Historical Society, felt a strong statement must be made to the tribes indicating this action.

The TABLING of the bill CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY. Senator Crippen felt the committee all agreed with the scope and purpose of the bill, but felt it deserved more time, rather than being hurriedly passed out with the possibility of missing important points.

#### SENATE BILL 373

Recommendation and Vote: Senator Halligan MOVED that Senate Bill 373 BE TABLED. The MOTION CARRIED on a vote of 4 to 3, the YES votes being Senators Bishop, Brown, Halligan and Yellowtail. The NO votes were Senators Jenkins, Harp and Crippen.

After more discussion, Senator Halligan MOVED that Senate Bill 373 BE RECONSIDERED. The MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY. The committee decided, in deference to committee member Senator Pinsoneault, to act on the bill. He deserved an opportunity to defend the bill on the floor of the Senate, and would be able to if the bill came out with a committee recommendation.

Senator Halligan MOVED that Senate Bill 373 DO NOT PASS AS AMENDED. The MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

#### SENATE BILL 431

Amendments and Vote: Senator Harp MOVED the RACICOT AMENDMENTS. (Exhibit 1) The MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

Senator Halligan MOVED that Senator Van Valkenburg's proposed amendment defining "gross proceeds" on page 6, line 25 be adopted. The MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY. For remaining amendments, see Exhibit 2, Valencia Lane's notes.)

Senator Halligan MOVED that Senator Van Valkenburg's suggested amendment on page 11, line 7 be adopted ("or any other person"). The MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

After some discussion, Senator Jenkins MOVED Phil Strope's suggested amendments regarding hours of operation. The MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

Senator Halligan MOVED an amendment stating, if the principal purpose of an establishment is gaming, they do not have to have a liquor license i.e. a bingo parlor. The MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

Senator Harp MOVED an amendment on page 30, line 24 and on page 35, line 15, to strike "\$300" and insert " \$100". The MOTION CARRIED on a vote of 4 to 3. The YES votes Senators Bishop, Crippen, Brown and Yellowtail. The NO votes were Senators Jenkins, Halligan and Beck.

Senator Harp MOVED an amendment on page 6, line 21, inserting a definition as follows: "used or intended for use in any gambling activity". The MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.

Senator Harp MOVED an amendment on page 45, line 5, striking "20 or any combination..." and inserting "5 poker and 15 keno machines". The MOTION FAILED by a vote of 3 to 4. The YES votes were Senators Beck, Harp and Crippen. The NO votes were Senators Jenkins, Yellowtail, Halligan and Bishop.

Senator Harp MOVED an amendment on page 34, line 9, striking "3%" and inserting "5%". The MOTION CARRIED by a vote of 4 to 3 with Senators Bishop Beck, Yellowtail and Harp voting YES, and Senators Halligan, Jenkins and Crippen voting NO.

Senator Harp MOVED an amendment on page 54, line 9, striking "1 and inserting "\$10". The MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

Senator Harp MOVED Senate Bill 431 DO PASS AS AMENDED. The MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.
