EXECUTIVE ACTION ON HOUSE BILL 318

- Chairman Hager called for action on HB 318: This is a bill to increase the maximum penalty for knowingly transporting, interring, or disposing of a dead body without a permit or for refusing to provide information required by law.
- <u>Discussion:</u> Committee members briefly discussed points of the bill and recalled that neither proponents or opponents appeared at the hearing on March 20, 1989.
- Recommendation and Vote: Senator Lynch made a MOTION THAT HOUSE BILL 318 BE CONCURRED IN. Senators in favor, 6; opposed, 0.
- Senator Hager will carry HB 318 to the Senate floor.

EXECUTIVE ACTION ON HOUSE BILL 319

Chairman Hager called for action on HB 319: HB 319 is an act authorizing the Department of Health and Environmental Sciences to prescribe the time frame within which a death or fetal death certificate must be filed.

Discussion: None

Recommendation and Vote: Senator McLane made a MOTION THAT HOUSE BILL 319 BE CONCURRED IN. Senators in favor, 5; opposed 0.

Senator Hager will carry HB 319 to the Senate floor.

EXECUTIVE ACTION ON HOUSE BILL 389

- Chairman Hager called for action on HB 389: Senator Hager stated this bill clarifies the definition of the practice of Practical Nursing.
- Discussion: Senator Rasmussen stated he felt it would be of benefit to pass this bill. Senator Lynch stated he would speak against a motion to concur because he believes the bill changes substantially what the law was intended to be. He believes there are better ways to "legitimatize" what is presently going on. Senator Rasmussen stated he recalled in testimony that most states do not have this language, and it is apparently working well in 47 other states to have this "predictable outcome" out of the law. He reminded the Committee the Hospital Association supported the bill. Senator Hager stated he has heard from people on both sides. Senator Himsl stated this is a nebulous sort of restriction, it being difficult to know what the outcome is going to be.
- Senator Hager asked Donna Small, R.N., if this language was stricken, would the bill compare to other states. She stated she was on the Board of Nursing at the time the language was selected. In 1978 the Board of Nursing set up a task force to study the Nursing Practice Act, spending three years studying it with input from LPNs, RNs, and anyone who wanted to participate. At that time the only model language available was that put out by the ANA. That language by the ANA Model Practice Act for LPNs used this language. Since the nurses changed the language in 1981, that was the language selected by the LPNs. It was not selected by RNs in any way.
- Recommendation and Vote: Senator Rasmussen made a MOTION
 THAT HOUSE BILL 389 BE CONCURRED IN. Senators in
 favor, 2; opposed, 5. MOTION FAILED. Bill recommended
 BE NOT CONCURRED IN.

EXECUTIVE ACTION ON HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION 15

Chairman Hager called for action on HJR 15: This is a joint Resolution of the Senate and House urging the Department of Family Services to review data needs and to develop and implement an automated management

information system on children in out-of-home placements and services provided to meet the needs of these children.

Discussion: The Committee briefly discussed the amendments.

Recommendation and Vote: Senator Rasmussen MOVED THAT THE AMENDMENTS BE ADOPTED ON HOUSE RESOLUTION 15.

Senators in favor, 7; opposed, 0. AMENDMENTS ADOPTED UNANIMOUSLY.

Senator McLane made a motion that HJR 15 BE ADOPTED AS AMENDED. Senators in favor, 7; opposed 0. RESOLUTION ADOPTED.

After some discussion Senator McLane moved that the COMMITTEE RECONSIDER ITS ACTION ON HJR 15. Senators in favor, 4; opposed, 0. ACTION RECONSIDERED.

Senator McLane made a MOTION THAT HJR 15, WITH AMENDMENTS, BE TABLED. Senators in favor, 4; opposed, 0.


