MONTANA SENATE 51st LEGISLATURE - SPECIAL SESSION

COMMITTEE ON EDUCATION AND CULTURAL RESOURCES

Call to Order: By Chairman H.W. Hammond, on July 8, 1989, at 12:30 p.m.

ROLL CALL

Members Present: Senator John Anderson, Senator Chet Blaylock, Senator Bob Brown, Senator Joe Mazurek, Senator Pat Regan, Senator Bill Farrell, Senator Dick Pinsoneault, Senator Dennis Nathe, and Senator H.W. Hammond

Announcements/Discussion: None

DISCUSSION ON HOUSE BILL 28

- Chairman Hammond stated that the present form HB 28 was in, would hurt 80% of the schools in Montana. Chairman Hammond asked if anyone had any amendments to offer. Chairman Hammond explained that there were 4 amendments by Representative John Cobb to be examined by the Committee.
- An executive action sheet on HB 28, 3rd reading copy, was handed out to the Committee members. The sheet explained the motions and amendments offered by the Committee at the July 7 executive action meeting. (SEE EXHIBIT 15)
- Senator Pinsoneault stated that he had one final amendment. (SEE EXHIBIT 16)
- Senator Pinsoneault said that the amendment would explain to the people in Montana why the Committee opposed the income surtax.

Motion: Senator Pinsoneault moved exhibit 16.

Discussion: Chairman Hammond indicated that Senator

Pinsoneault had an amendment similar to exhibit 16, yesterday. Senator Pinsoneault stated that this amendment would put this language into the statute.

- Senator Blaylock asked the Committee to oppose the amendment.
- Senator Pinsoneault stated that people know that a large hunk of their taxes goes into the education system. Senator Pinsoneault stated, "The pink tax property form that comes out every 6 months is pretty clear as to where the bulk of that money goes." He explained that what this amendment does was tell people that they are addressing the education funding problem. He explained, "That in addressing that funding problem, we are dinging you for 10% more, and the reason we are doing it is because the money is going exclusively to the funding problem."
- Senator Farrell stated that the general feeling about the HB 28 was not very good, and that the Committee had passed amendments yesterday, in lieu of a sales tax. He indicated to the Committee that maybe they should start discussing the sales tax.
- The motion by Senator Pinsoneault was not withdrawn or substituted.
- Motion: Senator Farrell called for a vote on how many members could support HB 28, in its present form.
- <u>Discussion:</u> Senator Brown indicated to Chairman Hammond maybe he should see if anyone was willing to move HB 28 TO BE CONCURRED IN.
- Chairman Hammond asked if anyone was prepared to make a motion to pass HB 28. No one from the Committee moved HB 28 To Be Concurred In.
- Senator Farrell suggested that the Committee take another look at SB 203 as it came from the House Select Committee in regular session. He also stated he would like the Committee to discuss a general sales tax as well.
- Senator Blaylock stated that the Committee would be better off if they took the bill and stripped the Senate Education Committee amendments off of it.
- Motion: Senator Farrell moved to strip the House Amendments and any previous Senate Education Amendments to bring

HB 28 to its original introduced form.

Discussion: None

- Amendments, Discussion, and Votes: The question was called and a roll call vote was taken. The motion carried unanimously.
- The Committee could not get copies of HB 28 in its original form, so they used copies of SB 7 which was identical to HB 28 and close to SB 203.
- Representative Glasser explained what SB 203 consisted of, when it came out of the House Select Committee.
- Senator Farrell stated he thought it would be easier to go through each issue in exhibit 23.
- Senator Nathe suggested to the Committee that he would go through each issue (in exhibit 23) to explain the differences and similarities between SB 7 and his bill, SB 20.
- Senator Mazurek asked Senator Nathe if SB 20 was essentially the same as SB 203 as it passed the House in regular session, and as it went through the conference committee. Senator Nathe replied that he put retirement back into the general fund and he took kindergarten out.
- Senator Nathe used EXHIBIT 23 to explain how SB 20 and SB 7 differs from SB 203.
- 1.) Senator Nathe stated that issue #1 the Mandatory County Retirement, SB 7 reads the way SB 203 use to. He stated that SB 7 had the teacher's retirement in a separate fund, it eliminated the levy, and it used state aid to fund the district's actual costs. He asked the Committee to circle SB 7 as being identical to SB 203 as it came back from the House.
- 2.) Allowable District Levy for Comprehensive Insurance. Senator Nathe stated SB 20 was the way SB 203 read when it came back from the House. He said that they only funded 90% of the comprehensive insurance.
- 3.) Foundation Program Schedules. Senator Nathe told the Committee to circle SB 20 as being identical to 203.
- 4.) The Mandatory 45-Mill Levy. Senator Nathe stated that SB 20 was at 75 mills and SB 7 was at 120 mills. Senator Nathe explained that SB 203 came back from the

House with 100 mills. Senator Mazurek stated that it would be 34 elementary mills and 21 high school mills and 45 statewide mills. (Senator Nathe indicated neither SB 20 or SB 7 were identical to SB 203.)

- 5.) Permissive Levies. Senator Nathe stated SB 7 and SB 20 was the same as SB 203.
- 6.) No Statutory Expenditure Limitations. Senator Nathe stated that SB 20 as being the same to SB 203.
- 7.) State Revenue. Senator Nathe stated that there was no funding in SB 203 except for the 100 mills. He explained that the other funding for SB 203 was in SB 468 which died in the conference committee. He told the Committee to strike out both SB 20 and SB 7.
- 8.) County Equalization Revenues. Senator Nathe explained that both SB 7 and SB 20 were identical to SB 203.
- 9.) PL 874. Senator Nathe stated SB 20 and SB 7 was identical to SB 203.
- 10.) General Fund Reserve. Senator Nathe explained that SB 7 and SB 20 was identical to SB 203.
- 11.) Foundation Program Structure and Schedules Based on School Size. Senator Nathe stated SB 20 was the same as SB 203.
- 12.) Minimum 180 days. Senator Nathe explained SB 20 and SB 7 was the same as SB 203.
- 13.) State equalize Aid Payments. Senator Nathe stated SB 20 and SB 7 was the same as SB 203.
- 14.) Building Debt Service-Interim study of Needs & Methods of Equalization. Senator Nathe said SB 20 and SB 7 was the same as SB 203.
- 15.) Transportation. Senator Nathe said SB 20 was the same as SB 203.
- 16.) Special Ed. Senator Nathe stated SB 20 was the same as SB 203.
- 17.) Additional Components. Senator Nathe said SB 7 and SB 20 was the same as SB 203.
- 18.) Phase-in. Senator Nathe explained SB 7 and SB 20 was the same as SB 203.

Senator Mazurek asked Madalyn Quinlan if they used the guaranteed tax base to fund retirement only, and what would the general fund cost be to the state? Madalyn Quinlan stated that the cost of the state guaranteeing retirement at 18.43, would be \$16.9 million.

ISSUE #1

- Motion: Senator Farrell moved issue #1 in exhibit 23.

 Senator Farrell moved to fund retirement using the guaranteed tax base concept (it would be outside the general fund).
- Discussion: Senator Mazurek asked if Senator Farrell was looking at a new source of revenue to fund it? Senator Mazurek asked if the Committee could revisit issue #1 if they don't have the money, or will they study it? Senator Farrell stated that the Committee would revisit issue #1 if they didn't have the funds.
- Amendments, Discussion, and Votes: The question was called for and a voice vote was taken. The motion carried with Senator Regan voting no.

ISSUE #2

- Senator Mazurek stated that the Committee should stay with SB 203 with the 100% of 1988 costs in the Foundation Program schedule base.
- Motion: Senator Mazurek moved issue #2. It would eliminate the levy; Insurance in GF; 100% of 1988 costs in Foundation Program schedule base.

Discussion: None

Amendments, Discussion, and Votes: The question was called for and a voice vote was taken. The motion carried unanimously.

ISSUE #3

- Motion: Senator Brown moved to adopt SB 20 language which stated, "FP schedules for FY 1991 based on: 90% of districts' 1988 GF (minus Special Ed. & PL 874) and 100% of insurance (minus PL 874).
- <u>Discussion:</u> Senator Mazurek stated that he would along with the motion reluctantly, because this was biggest hit to schools.
- Amendments, Discussion, and Votes: The question was called

for and a voice vote was taken. The motion carried with Senator Regan voting no.

ISSUE #4

Senator Farrell suggested to the Committee that they adopt 34 elementary + 21 high school = 55 mills plus the 45 mills. He stated he would like to revisit issue #4 when they get to issue #7.

Motion: Senator Brown moved to adopt 34 elementary mills and 21 high school mills plus 45 state mills = 100 total mills.

Discussion: None

Amendments, Discussion, and Votes: The question was called for and a voice vote was taken. The motion carried unanimously.

ISSUE #5

Senator Nathe stated that there will be a mandatory county levy with a guaranteed tax base to support the retirement.

The Committee stated that issue #5 required no change.

ISSUE #6

Motion: Senator Farrell moved the language from SB 20 on
 issue #6 (exhibit 23).

Discussion: None

Amendments, Discussion, and Votes: The question was called for and a voice vote was taken. The motion carried unanimously.

ISSUE #7

Senator Farrell stated this was where he wanted to introduce the sales tax. Senator Farrell stated that he did not have an exact sales tax bill to present, but he would propose a 4% sales tax. He stated that the Committee had worked at equalizing school funding for some time. He explained that not one of the plans the Committee had been working on would work unless the Committee had some additional revenue.

Motion: Senator Farrell moved a 4% sales tax proposal.

- <u>Discussion:</u> Senator Brown thought that a sales tax bill should be referred to the Taxation Committee rather than trying to amended a sales tax into the current bill.
- Senator Farrell stated that he did not see a problem with that suggestion. He said that he had an outline on what a sales tax should look like. Senator Farrell wanted to know if the Senate Education Committee had come to the point of an alternative revenue source to make the equalization plan work.
- Senator Mazurek explained that he and the rest of the Democrats in the Committee were not prepared to discuss a sales tax. Senator Mazurek stated that he would like a chance to discuss a sales tax with their leadership in a caucus.
- Senator Regan said she was adamantly against a sales tax and she thought it was wrong to use education to bring a sales tax about.
- Senator Pinsoneault stated that they had discussed every revenue raising mechanism, whether it was to reduce the personal property on down the line. He said that they do it in the name of education.
- Senator Blaylock asked Senator Farrell if the Committee put a sales tax into the bill, then it passed the Senate and the House, would it go to the people for approval? Senate Farrell explained that he had a sales tax bill and that it could be written into any one of the sales tax bills. Senator Farrell said, "Basically what we have is about \$142 million for education through the Senate Committee, stuck into this bill. The personal property reform at 4% is \$40 million; income tax and pension reform is \$40 million, low income rebate is \$15.6 million...local government allocations and that's a block grant to the personal property of \$10 million, the University System \$28 million, and administrations \$4 million...What I would like to do is have a vote of the people in 1990 but implement it in January of this year."
- Senator Regan stated that there were two problems with a sales tax besides general acceptance. 1.) "You must immediately place a referendum on the issue." 2.) "How long does it take before the...real money starts coming in?"
- Senator Farrell stated that we probably start seeing the revenue by July of 1990. Senator Farrell said, "What

I'm suggesting is that we go ahead and put it on the ballot in 1990 for the November election in 1990, and implement it a year before it is approved."

- Senator Regan asked whether there would be anything that would preclude a referendum that would call for an immediate vote before it could be put in place? Greg Petesch stated that they could not refer appropriations to the people.
- Senator Regan asked Greg Petesch if he indicated that an appropriation can not be challenged but the imposition of a tax can be challenged by the votes? Greg Petesch replied, "You can not refer a portion of a bill to the people. That's the problem here. You have to have the bill become effective someway or another. If it has an appropriation in this bill, the constitution prohibits you from referring it to the people. Mr. Petesch explained that an initiative would be different, where the people would petition to place a law before themselves. Mr. Petesch stated that there were two forms of a referendums 1.) Where you directly refer something to the people to have it become effective.

 2.) You enact something and they petition to, in effect, review your action.
- Mr. Petesch explained that if this bill were to be referred to the Governor, and he signed it, and it had an appropriation in it, the people could not petition for a referendum.
- Senator Regan stated that maybe the Taxation Committee should be brought in here to hammer out a tax reform package that would find some support in our communities. She stated that she thought the sales tax was a dead issue for the school equalization funding bill.
- Senator Pinsoneault suggested that the Committee should take the money that was available, and show what they could come with by keeping it balanced without a surtax or without going into the hole. He said, "Show everyone if you want education funded at that level, this is what is going to happen." He stated on the other hand, here is a sales tax and show what we can do for education. Senator Pinsoneault stated that this would be a way to help people understand the problem.
- Senator Regan asked Madalyn Quinlan if SB 203 could have been funded (with 100 mills) with available revenues? Ms. Quinlan stated SB 203 could be funded using the

general fund revenue. She said, "As a result, you would create a black hole, given the general fund revenues that were currently projected." Ms. Quinlan stated that the calculation was figured without a surtax.

Senator Farrell withdrew his motion.

Senator Mazurek asked Madalyn Quinlan to get some figures for the Committee on how much general fund money was needed to fund at 75 mills, 85 mills etc... He wanted to know what the Committee could do with those revenues.

Senator Farrell suggested that the Committee should adjourn and meet with their caucuses on Monday and then come back and work on the bill.

Motion: Senator Farrell moved to adjourn.

Chairman Hammond stated that the Committee would convene in room 325 after the Senate adjourns on Monday.

EXECUTIVE ACTION ON HB 28, 3RD READING COPY SENATE EDUCATION COMMITTEE

July 7, 1989

- Motion by Sen. Blaylock to remove from HB 28 the coordination instruction in section 97 which would have added any approved foundation program schedule increase for FY 1990 into the schedules in HB 28. Motion passed, 6 - 2
- 2. Motion by Sen. Farrell to reduce the statewide mill levy from 45 mills to 30 mills (for total of 85 mills). Motion failed, 6-3
- 3. Motion by Sen. Farrell to reduce the statewide mill levy from 45 mills to 35 mills (for total of 90 mills). Motion failed, 5 4
- 4. Motion by Sen. Farrell to reduce the statewide mill levy from 45 mills to 40 mills (for total of 95 mills). Motion passed, 5 4
- 5. Motion by Sen. Farrell to reduce the overschedule permissive levy to a level that combined with the foundation program amount would bring districts to 90% of average FY 1988 expenditures without a voted levy, rather than 100%. Motion failed, 8 1
- 6. Motion by Sen Mazurek to change the permissive levy to a phased-in mandatory obligation of districts. Districts would be required to finance a nonvoted amount equal to 10% of the district foundation program amount in FY 1991 and 20% of the foundation program amount thereafter. Motion passed, 5 4
- 7. Motion by Sen. Farrell to remove the "Daily" exemption from the expenditure cap. Motion passed, 8 1
- 8. Motion by Sen. Regan to remove the provision which would have temporarily diverted the coal severance tax parks acquisition fund (5%) to state equalization aid. Motion passed, 6 2
- 9. Motion by Sen. Pinsoneault to add to the bill title language that would indicate that the income tax surcharge was "in lieu of a general sales tax". Motion passed 8 1
- 10. Motion by Sen. Pinsoneault to add to the statement of intent language stating that the income tax surcharge is not intended to provide a long-term solution to the school equalization problems. Motion passed, 7 1
- 11. Motion by Sen. Pinsoneault to add as a duty for the legislative oversight committee in the bill the "assessment

- of administrative costs of public school services in Montana." Motion passed, unanimous
- 12. Motion by Sen. Brown to make effective for FY 1990 the increased bonus payments for districts which consolidated in FY 1989. Motion passed, unanimous
- 13. Motion by Sen. Nathe to reduce the local government severance tax rates on oil and gas to the levels in SB 26 (oil-8.4%; gas-15.25%; strippers 4.2%)
- 14. Substitute motion by Sen. Mazurek to lower the rates, but also restore the statewide levy to 45 mills (100 mills total). Motion passed, 5 4
- 15. Motion by Sen. Farrell to require districts to use any cash reappropriated from a previous fiscal year for first reducing the voted levy, then the mandatory overschedule amount, then any other district levies.

1. Page 142, line 22. Following: "SURTAX."

Strike: remainder of line 22 through page 143, line 1.

Insert: "As part of the equalization of funding for Montana public schools and in lieu of a general sales tax, each person required to file a Montana individual income tax return shall pay, in addition to the tax liability computed as required in 15-30-103, an education surtax of 10% of the tax liability. Montana individual income tax return forms must indicate that the surtax imposed under this section is an education surtax and is assessed in lieu of a general sales tax."



- 1. Fund the foundation schedules at 90% of 1988 actual expenditures for general fund and insurance -- 26.30% elem; 37.7% category (8) elem; 34.81% high school
- 2. Retained guaranteed tax base (GTB) for county retirement funding, but remove GTB for voted levy
- Removed permissive levy provision and its GTB funding mechanism from bill
- 4. Remove recapture provision and provided for cap at 133% of foundation program (same as 117% of 100% of 1988 funding)
- 5. Removed coordination clause (Section 97) which would have added to the foundation schedules any increase approved in passage of HB 6
- 6. Retained flat tax on coal, gas, and oil, but reduced oil and gas local severance tax rates to original Senate amendments; clarified distribution of the flat taxes to appropriate taxing jurisdictions
- 7. Included as funding source 15% of the coal severance tax interest; effective FY 1991
- 8. Included as funding source 8% individual income and corporate income and license surtax; applied in 1990
- 9. Retained 100 mills; retained abolishment of education trust fund and allocation of funds to state equalization
- 10. Removed the House amendment by Rep. Daily regarding an exemption from the general fund cap
- 11. Removed temporary diversion of coal severance tax parks acquisition funds to state equalization
- 12. Added duty of oversight committee to study school administrative costs
- 13. Added language (in title and page 6) indicating that income surtax is "in lieu of a general sales tax" and not intended to be permanent source of funding
- 14. Made effective for FY 1990 the bonus payments for districts that consolidated in FY 1989
